SUBJECT: re: Result of Public Hearing on Draft Municipal Ordinance No. 2018-008 - "An Ordinance Prescribing The New Fare Rates For Motorized Tricycles Operating In The Municipality of Tigbauan, Province of Iloilo."

"FINDINGS/CONCLUSIONS:

A public hearing was conducted on December 4, 2018, 3:30 PM. at the Tigbauan Covered Gym with the presence of the following: (yours truly), Hon. John Gershwin C. Tueres, Hon. Suzette Marie Hilado-Banno, Hon. Ma. Gerrylin Santuyo-Camposagrado, Hon. Neri T. Camiña, Chief of Police Hermogenes Eulatic, Mr. Rommel Mliciano, Mr. Ronnie Detoperez-Pres. TEDOA, Mr. Leonardo M. Nulod-Pres. NBBA, Mr. Danilo Tupino-Secretary STCTODA, other routes representatives, Barangay Captains and other Barangay Officials, Department Heads, School Heads, OSCA Head and other concerned persons.

1. That Pursuant to Section 447 Paragraph 3 (vi), Article 3, chapter 3, Title 2, Book II of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the LTRFB franchising functions, powers and responsibilities over tricycles-for-hire have been devolved to the Local Government Units effective July 1,1992;
2. By virtue of such devolution, the Sangguniang Bayan is empowered to determine, fix, prescribe, or periodically adjust fares or rates for the service provided in a zone after public hearing;
3. Due to the increase in the prices of gasoline, oil spare parts, and commodities, the five (5) Tricycle Owners & drivers association in this municipality, namely: Tigbauan Tricycle Owners And Drivers Association (TTODA), Poblacion-Buyuan Tricycle Owners and Drivers Association (PBTODA), Samahan ng Tigbauan Cordova Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (STCTODA), Tigbauan Econobike Drivers and Owners Association (TEDOA) and Samahan ng Tigbauan Tricycle Rotta Namoccon-Banguingin-Barroc-Atabayon (NBBA) Route have submitted to the Sangguniang Bayan their respective formal requests/petitions for fare increase. Thus, the SB Committee on Transportation decided to Schedule a public hearing last November 15, 2018 but this was deferred for further study of the proposed draft ordinance. Because of the recent roll back of fuel prices the TTODA, PBTODA, TEDOA, & NBBA routes where amenable to maintain the old fare rate as reflected in Municipal Ordinance No. 2011-001. Only the STCTODA Route decided to push through with their petition for fare increase;
4. In view thereof, the SB Committee on Transportation has come-up with its amended Draft Municipal Ordinance No. 2018-008, wherein all the fare rates which are amenable to all routes are reflected to be presented during the December 4, 2018 scheduled 2nd public hearing;
5. As a result of the exhaustive discussions during this 2nd public hearing, the following comments, corrections, suggestions to the proposed fare rates of the 5 routes as provided under Sec. 1 of Draft Municipal Ordinance No. 2018-008 were noted down:

I. TTODA (Pob. – Jamog Route)

- By Punong Barangay Romeo Somodio of Brgy. Sermon – to correct the fare rate of Crossing Sermon from P19.00 to P17.00; Sermon proper from P17.00 to P19.00. (Well taken.)
- By Mrs. Herminia Tualdon, Principal METES Elem. School – to correct the fare rate of crossing Guisian from P22.00 to P17.00.
- By Punong Barangay Armando Tidula of Brgy. Nagba – suggested to reduce the fare rate of Barangay Nagba to P15.00; suggested to indicate Nagba Proper & Crossing Nagba.

Hon. Tuares – explained that for TTODA Route, they have decided not to push through with their petition for fare increase. They were amenable to maintain the old fare rate except that there are some corrections in the old ordinance (based on the aforementioned corrections as presented by Punong Barangay Somodio and Mrs. Herminia Tualdon. (Well taken). This was also explained by Hon. John Gershwin Tueres and the query of Brgy. 1 (Pob.) Kagawad. Kerwin Infante, was clarified by Hon. Camposagrado if there is a fare increase petition from TTODA Route. Hon. Tueres said there was none but it is only a validation of the old fare rate.

II. Re: PBTODA Route:

- By Punong Barangay Ubang of Brgy. Bagacay - Suggested to reduce the fare rate of Bolocau Boundary from P12.00 to P10.00 which is the minimum rate. (Well taken)
- By Punong Barangay Tahinay of Brgy. Supa – pointed out that although the new fare rate for Brgy. Supa is P15.00 they even pay P20.00. And this concern for the plight of tricycle drivers was appreciated by Hon. Tuares.

III. Re: STCTODA Route:

- Mr. Danilo Tupino – discussed the basis of their petition for fare increase which is, 1st 5 km. P10.00 (near the house of ex-Punong Barangay. Perpetua Terania of Brgy. Napnapan Sur); in excess of 5 km. P12.00 until the house of Mr. Agape Ambay (6km.); thereafter, they charge P14.00.
- By Punong Barangay Romeo Alcala and Kagawad Tanya Alcala of Brgy. Bangkal- suggested to reduce the fare from Libas to Brgy. Bangkal and Sitio Nasuli to P17.00 instead of P20.00 which is quite expensive.
- Punong Barangay Nelcee Joy Guarin of Brgy. Cordova Norte– suggested to reduce the fare rates from P16.00 to P15.00 only.

IV. TEDOA Route:

- Mr. Willie Tiu – inquired if the baggages which have the same rate with the passengers could be placed inside the vehicle; if the baggage gets wet, is the driver liable? ; also suggested to extend their operation during nighttime until 9:30 P.M.
- Hon. Tuares – made a positive response and explained that his concern could be discussed or settled by the passenger and the driver themselves.;

Re: suggestion to extend their operation until 9:30 P.M., Mr. Danilo Tupino said, there are more or less 10 units of tricycles from other routes operating until 10.00 P.M.. But in the case of STCTODA Route they can extend up to 9:00 P.M. only.

V. NBBA Route:

- Punong Barangay Leonardo Nulod of Barangay Barroc informed that so far no one complained on the proposed fare rates for the NBBA Route. Their association in fact considered the plight of students by reducing their fare rates on the following:

- Baguingin to Namocon – P5.00
 - Baguingin to Barroc - P6.00 or P8.00
- for students only

But for regular passengers, they collect P10.00.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Committee hereby recommends to adopt the following recommendations:

- To consider all corrections, amendments, suggestions as decided/agreed during the public hearing.
- To Calendar for second reading the Draft Municipal Ordinance No. 2018-008 as amended/corrected.”


