**“FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS:**

1. After the **ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF THE ATTENDEES/PARTICIPANTS**, the Sponsor made **BRIEF REMARKS/BACKGROUND** regarding proposed ordinance.
2. Dir. John Esar T. David of the CSC Iloilo Provincial Field Office discussed about the **BACKGROUND** on **“THE PHILIPPINE CIVIL SERVICE HONOR AWARDS PROGRAM”**.
3. Then, Hon. Atty. Suzette Tenefrancia- Alquisada, Municipal Mayor delivered a **SHORT MESSAGE** and gave her commitment and support to the proposed ordinance.
4. Hon. Camposagrado thoroughly discussed the salient provisions of Draft Municipal Ordinance No. 2019-002 comprising of 10 sections, to wit:
  - i. Section 1. BASIC POLICIES.
  - ii. Section 2. OBJECTIVES
  - iii. Section 3. SCOPE.
  - iv. Section 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS.
  - v. Section 5. AWARDS AND INCENTIVES.
  - vi. Section 6. FORMS OF AWARDS AND INCENTIVES.
  - vii. Section 7. PRAISE COMMITTEE
  - viii. Section 8. FUNDING.
  - ix. Section 9. REPEALING CLAUSE:
  - x. Section 10. EFFECTIVITY

**5. COMMENTS/SUGGESTIONS** relative to Draft Municipal Ordinance no. 2019-002

Under Section 5.2 on LGU-Awards, Mrs. Phoebe Torrico (Aquaculturist II) – inquired about the possibility of including the career advancement incentive for municipal officials and employees since it is stated under no. 5 of 5.2.2 to wit: “5. Such other awards which the LGU may decide to give under existing Ordinances.”

The proponent explained that such incentive was intentionally not incorporated in the proposed measure to lessen the financial obligation of the LGU. As discussed by the good Mayor, this award/incentive is included in the computation of the PS limitation requirement. In the case of the LGU, however, under the administration of Mayor Alquisada, Career advancements are also being recognized, and incentives are given in the form of giving promotion to employees and of placing qualified persons to the right positions.

Dir. David explained that Career Advancement Incentive is only one of the suggested incentives, depending on the financial capability of the LGU.


**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Since there were no further comments and violent reactions on the proposed ordinance, and Dir. David said that the draft ordinance is almost complete in itself,


1. The committee moves for the adoption of this committee report;
