

2) Board Resolution; 3) Certificate of Registration; 4) List of Current Officers and Members; 5) Annual Accomplishment Report; 6) Financial Statement; 7) Organization Profile; Copy of Minutes of Organizational Meeting;

RECOMMENDATIONS:


