The session opened with prayers led by the Presiding Officer. Attendance was checked by the Secretary. Reading of the previous minutes followed.

The approval of the Honorable Secretary of the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources was read to the body.

The separation of speed limit and ordinance in Municipal Ordinance No. 4 s. 1966 was recommended during the meeting of the ISF Advisory Council. It was also suggested in said meeting that curfew be imposed on minors or those below 21 years of age unless accompanied by parents or guardians. This was put into action by Honorable Lorenzo Tarrilla, Sr. and seconded by Honorable Jose Furida.

Resolution No. 62, s. 1977

RESOLUTION TO REPELATE THE SPEED AND UNNECESSARY TOTTING OF ENGINES AND LOUD NOISE OF MOTOR ENGINES OF VEHICLES DRIVING ON THE NATIONAL AND PROVINCIAL HIGHWAYS AND MUNICIPAL STREETS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIGBAUAN, PROVINCE OF ILOILO, PHILIPPINES.

WHEREAS, due to ~~the~~ attentions to over-speeding and reckless driving by some chauffeurs, accidents happen, resulting in destruction of property and loss of lives and/or limbs of some passengers and pedestrians;

WHEREAS, to discourage over speeding and reckless driving and to better safeguard properties and the loss of lives and limbs of the riding public as well as pedestrians;

WHEREAS, due to numerous complaints of the public due to unnecessary tooting of horns by chauffeurs and loud noise of engines of these motor vehicles especially scooters and tricycles;

AND, WHEREAS, on motion of Honorable Lorenzo Terrilla, Sr. and duly seconded by Honorable Jose Ruidia;

BE IT RESOLVED, to adopt as it is hereby adopted, the following ordinance;

Ordinance No. 41, s. 1977

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES TRAVELING ON THE NATIONAL AND PROVINCIAL HIGHWAYS AND THE MUNICIPAL STREETS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIBURON, ILOILO, PHILIPPINES PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

SECTION 1 - This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Regulating the Speed of Motor Vehicles Traveling the National and Provincial Highways and the Municipal Streets within the Jurisdiction of Tiburon, Iloilo, Philippines, Providing Penalties therefor and for Other Purposes.

SECTION 2 - It shall be unlawful for all motor vehicles traveling on the National and Provincial Highways and Municipal streets within the Jurisdiction of the Municipality of Tiburon, Iloilo, Philippines, to run at speed exceeding twenty kilometers per hour.

SECTION 3 - Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than fifty (P50.00) pesos but not exceeding one hundred twenty-five (P125.00) pesos or an imprisonment of not less than four (4) days but not exceeding ten (10) days, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

SECTION 4 - Any Ordinance or part of ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5 - Effectivity - This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its approval.
