The Presiding Officer led the opening prayers. The Sangguniang Bayan Clerk checked the attendance in the absence of the Sangguniang Bayan Secretary.

The Presiding Officer informed the Honorable Body of the Memo Circular from the Ministry of Local Government asking on all Sangguniang Bayan Secretaries to attend a seminar on codification at the UP Law Center, Manila. The date, however, for the seminar sponsored by NEDCO and LAPMAAP was not specified. Honorable Esteban Tundasang inquired the body on the purpose of the seminar. Honorable Ramon Travilla suggested that a special session be called and the Municipal Treasurer be invited to attend so that the body can deliberate on the travel expenses needed.

The Presiding Officer read the radio-message which called for attendance of both the NDC and the HDO to a three (3) week seminar workshop at Angeles City Pangasinan with a registration fee of one thousand two hundred (P1,200.00) pesos each. Travel expenses can be charged to 20% Development Funds of the Municipality. Honorable Theodore Tueres suggested to charge the amount to "Management Tools". Honorable Esteban Tundasang then moved to appropriate the amount of one thousand one hundred fifteen and 40/100 (P1,115.40) pesos for the travel expenses of the NDC chargeable against "Management Tools" of the Municipality. This was seconded by Honorable Andres Triste.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to forward copies of this resolution to Mrs. Kelly C. Sestola, Municipal Treasurer for her information and appropriate action.

Resolved to enact as it is hereby enacted to following
Ordinance to wit:

Ordinance No. 2, 1973

AN OUTRANCE ESTIMATING THE MINIMUM ANNUAL TOTAL OF FISHES SOME 4 OR LESS-ON OF THIS MUNICIPALITY FROM TWENTY THOUSAND (\$20,000.00) PERIOD TO THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND (\$35,000.00) PERIOD.

REMARKS: - Since 4 or Lin-40 is needed by increasing the Minimum Annual Rental from twenty thousand (\$20,000.00) Paces to Thirty-Five Thousand (\$35,000.00) Paces to read as follows:

1. Lim-aw the combination of Bayu and Bimlay sites 5 meters deep, located in front of Bayu-an Bridge, 572 meters from Darangay Bayu-an Boundary monument No. 1.

Minimum Annual Rental - - - - - \$35,000.00

SECTION 2 - This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval by the Honorable, the Secretary of Natural Resources.

APPENDIX 10

Respectable Ramon Torilla opposed to the public bidding of fishery site Gatahan. He favored socialization and reiterated his idea of nine thru cooperatives for the protection of fry catchers. The Presiding Officer then called for a division of the house.

Not in favor 1

The majority was in favor of sale of public bidding, so the resolution was carried. Honorable Jesus Lelouan suggested, public bidding by viva voce, however the Presiding Officer disclosed the disadvantages of the latter and affirmed that bidding by secret balloting is much better.
