Municipal Ordinance No. 96-005

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING CERTAIN STREETS NEAR TIGBAUAN PUBLIC MARKET DURING MARKET DAY (SUNDAY) AND PENALIZING VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Section 21 (a) & (d) of the Local Government Code of 1991 (RA 7160) states that "(a) a local government may pursuant to an ordinance, temporarily or permanently close any local road within its jurisdiction, (d) any municipality, by a duly enacted ordinance, temporarily close and regulate the use of any local street, road, thoroughfare or any public place where shopping malls, flea, or night markets, or shopping areas may be established and where goods, merchandise, foodstuffs, commodities, or articles of commerce may be sold and dispensed to the general public;

WHEREAS, it has been observed that certain vendors are now plying and selling their wares, goods, merchandise, commodities, foodstuffs and other articles of commerce outside the Tigbauan Public Market at Allera St., during Sunday (Market Day) (because they cannot be accommodated for lack of space inside) starting from corners Allera-Tejero Streets, up to and in front of Farm Breeders Poultry and Agricultural Store, Tigbauan Public Market, Tejero St. and other sidewalks of different streets in Barangay 9, Tigbauan, Iloilo during market days;

WHEREAS, this act is an encroachment on the proper use of streets by motor vehicles and sidewalks by pedestrians;

WHEREAS, there is a need to regulate the use of streets and sidewalks and/or its closure to benefit these vendors, market goers and/or buyers as well as the motor vehicles, pedestrians and shoppers who may be passing or using specific streets near the Tigbauan Public Market;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained, By The Sangguniang Bayan Of the Municipality of Tigbauan, Iloilo That:

SECTION 1. - During designated market day at the Tigbauan Public Market, the portion length of Allera St. starting from corners Allera-Tejero Streets and at Magsaysay monument in front of Gladys's Store up to corner of Leonardia Street shall be closed to vehicular traffic from 5:30 A.M. to 1:00 P.M.

SECTION 2. During designated market day at the Tigbauan Public Market, the vendors shall be allowed to display and sell their wares, goods, merchandise, foodstuffs, commodities or articles of commerce or road shoulder of Tejero Street starting from corners Allera-Tejero Streets up to and in front of Farm Breeder Poultry and Agricultural Store Tigbauan Public market starting 5:30 A.M. to 1:00 P.M.

SECTION 3. Market vendors are hereby allowed to display and sell their wares, goods, merchandise, foodstuffs, commodities or articles of commerce on the streets and its sidewalks designated in Section I and only during market day.

SECTION 4. It shall be illegal for market vendors to display and sell their wares, goods, merchandise, foodstuffs, commodities or articles of commerce in other streets and sidewalks not otherwise specified in Section I and II at or near the Tigbauan Public market during market day, such as but not necessarily limited to Tigbauan Public Plaza and its sidewalks, Barangay 9, Tigbauan.

SECTION 5. Any market vendor violating any portion of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than One Hundred Pesos (P100.00) but not more than Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) or both at the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinance, resolutions or Executive Orders inconsistent with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared illegal or unconstitutional and hence invalidated, these provisions hereto which are not affected thereby shall remain effective and enforceable.

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall take effect ten (100 days after its approval and posted in 3 conspicuous places.
