local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, Section 447 (2) (xvi) of the said Code mandates that the Sangguniang Bayan shall "regulate the numbering of residential, commercial and other buildings";

WHEREAS, the general use of the name or number of streets, zones and/or purok in the barangays of this Municipality as address of a particular house or building is inadequate, tedious and impractical and has caused confusion, conflicts and controversies among residents particularly in the implementation of projects, programs and activities of the government, or during government response to emergencies, calamities, violations of the law and the like;

WHEREAS, for proper and systematic inventory, monitoring and identification of residential, commercial, public and other buildings in this Municipality, proper house/building numbering is necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN IN SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. **TITLE**: "An Ordinance Regulating the Numbering of Residential, Commercial, Public and Other Buildings in the Municipality of Tigbauan, Province of Iloilo."

SECTION 2. **DEFINITION OF TERMS**. Terms used in this Ordinance:

- a. *Registry of Barangay Inhabitants* the list or registry of actual inhabitants who have resided in the barangay for at least six (6) months prior to the effectivity of this ordinance.
- b. **Residential house** refers to any building, structure or portion thereof that is primarily occupied, or designed or intended primarily for occupancy, as a residence by one or more households.
- c. **Residential building** refers to a building which provides more than half of its floor area for dwelling purposes, including a building that provides sleeping accommodation with or without cooking or dining or both facilities.
- d. **Commercial building** refers to a building used or constructed or adopted to be used wholly or partly for shops, private offices, banks, nursing homes, hotels, restaurants, beauty parlors, boutiques, video libraries, computer shops, cinemas and Auditoriums or any other such building used for similar purpose engaged in trade and commerce.
- e. **Public Building** a building used by the public for any purpose, such as assembly, education, entertainment, or worship; a building that belongs to the national government or local government unit, and is used by the public such as, but not limited to, schools, churches or places of worship, barangay halls, day care centers, multi-purpose halls, health centers and similar buildings.
- f. **Other Building** refers to a building or structure other than a residential house, residential building, commercial building and public building.

- g. *House/Building Number* the permanent number/code assigned to a house or building existing in the barangay.
- h. *Number code* The geographical code given to a particular barangay with corresponding number:

06	- Regional Code
05	- Provincial Code
5021	- Municipal Zip Code
01 to 52	- Barangay Number
R-001 onward	- Residential House Number
RB-001 onward	 Residential Building Number
RC-001 onward	- Residential/Commercial Building Number
C-001 onward	- Commercial Building Number
P-001 onward	- Public Building Number
OB-001 onward	- Other Building Number

SECTION 3. All Barangay Local Government Units (BLGUs) are mandated to implement the house/building numbering system in their respective barangay. The BLGU shall be responsible for preparing the registry of barangay inhabitants and designating the corresponding house/building numbers.

SECTION 4. All residential, commercial, public and other buildings in the municipality shall be numbered in accordance with the approved **barangay ordinance** based on the number/code indicated herein.

SECTION 5. The BLGU shall post a barangay map showing the numbered houses and buildings in their areas of jurisdiction.

SECTION 6. The house number shall be printed on a tin plate with dimension of 4 inches by $6\frac{1}{2}$ inches, the actual size of which is shown in the template illustrated below:

Example:



The number/code shall be installed in an area of the house/building where it is fully visible. The cost of the tin plate shall be chargeable to the house or building owner.

SECTION 7. It shall be unlawful for any person to remove, transfer, deface or otherwise destroy the house/building number. Any person violating this provision shall be penalized with a fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (₱2,500.00) or imprisonment of ten (10) days or both at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 8. **TRANSITORY PROVISION**. In cases where a house or building, or portion thereof, is located along the boundary of two (2) adjacent barangays, or where there is a boundary dispute between two (2) or more barangays and the exact geographical location of the house or building cannot be determined, the house/building number shall belong to the barangay (a) where its owner is officially registered as a voter, or (b) where its address in the building permit or business license is indicated; Provided, however, that after the boundary dispute has been finally settled, the house/building number shall be retained by or transferred to the proper barangay.

SECTION 9. **FUNDING**. An initial funding to defray the expenses necessary for or incidental to the implementation of this Ordinance in the amount of Three Hundred Thousand Pesos (₱300,000.00) shall be sourced from the fund of the Municipality of Tigbauan and is hereby allocated.

SECTION 10. **SEPARABILITY CLAUSE**. In the event that any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or word of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, other provisions thereof shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 11. **REPEALING CLAUSE**. All ordinances, as well as pertinent rules and regulations thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

SECTION 12. **EFFECTIVITY**. This Code shall be deemed effective upon approval and compliance with mandatory publication or posting.
