ORDINANCE DECLARING PATADYONG AS A MUNICIPAL TEXTILE AND SETTING THE GUIDELINES FOR ITS USE AND PROMOTION IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIGBAUAN, ILOILO.

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This ordinance shall also be known as “Patadyong Ordinance of Tigbauan.”

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF PRINCIPLES. The Municipality of Tigbauan, through this ordinance, enjoins in the preservation, enrichment, and dynamic evolution of a Filipino culture based on the principle of unity in diversity in a climate of free artistic and intellectual expression as it is stated on Section 16 of the Local Government Code that local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. As used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

- a. **Patadyong** - from the visayan word “patadlong” which translates to “to be left straight,” Patadyong is an indigenous rectangular or tube-like wrap around skirt with no pleats worn by both men and women of the Visayas islands. Patterns of stripes and plaids make this cloth distinct from the others;
- b. **Municipal Textile** - a type of cloth or woven fabric, historically proven to be part of Tigbauan’s history and culture, and continues to be a part of Tigbauan’s identity and its people’s sense of belonging;
- c. **Educational Institutions** - a place where Tigbauanons of different ages gain education, including preschools, childcare, primary-elementary schools, secondary schools, and colleges, and universities;
- d. **International Office or Agency** - any office or agency whose functions involve personnel and workers assigned in more than one country but has an office or agency address in any of the barangays in the Municipality of Tigbauan, Province of Iloilo;
- e. **National Office or Agency** - any office or agency whose functions involve personnel and workers assigned in more than one region in the Philippine but has an office or agency address in any of the barangays in the Municipality of Tigbauan, Province of Iloilo;
- f. **Establishments** - any business, facility, or office that has an address in any of the barangays in the Municipality of Tigbauan, Province of Iloilo;
- g. **Barangay Pasalubong Center** - an establishment meant to display Tigbauanon products and produce managed by the barangay located in any of the barangays in Tigbauan;
- h. **Municipal Pasalubong Center** - an establishment meant to display Tigbauanon products and produce managed by the Local Government Unit of Tigbauan.

SECTION 4. **PATADYONG AS A MUNICIPAL TEXTILE.** Through this Ordinance, Patadyong is hereby declared as the Municipal Textile of the Municipality of Tigbauan, Province of Iloilo. From hereon, Patadyong shall be treated and worn with respect and dignity as it embodies the culture, victories, and colorful journey of the past and present generations of Tigbauanons.

The Municipality of Tigbauan shall maximize its use in the municipality. Through the collaboration of the Local Government Unit and other stakeholders, the municipality shall endeavor to be one of the region’s biggest and best producers of patadyong. It shall organize and empower its local weavers to improve their production and quality of products.

SECTION 5. **OFFICIAL COLORS OF TIGBAUAN PATADYONG.** Through this ordinance, the following colors are hereby recognized as the official colors of Tigbauan Patadyong: **RED, YELLOW, GREEN.**

RED symbolizes the bravery and strength of Tigbauanons in recognition of the town’s past and present;

YELLOW represents Tigbauanons’ ability of being hopeful and visionary despite all odds; and

GREEN represents the town’s natural resources that are of great contribution in the progress and development of the municipality and the formation of the values and principles of its people.

However, despite this section, Patadyong Weavers and designers are not limited and are free to use their own artistic abilities to come up and produce colorful patadyongs as long as they do not degrade the Tigbauanon culture and heritage that patadyongs represent.

SECTION 6. TIGBAUAN PATADYONG MASTER PLAN. A master plan to promote Patadyong as a municipal textile shall be part of the Tourism Plan of the Municipality of Tigbauan. It must consist of activities and marketing strategies that will make Tigbauan's patadyong known and relevant in the changing times. It must be included on the LGU's AIP.

SECTION 7. USE OF TIGBAUAN PATADYONG IN UNIFORMS. The Local Government Unit of Tigbauan must be at the forefront of promoting and preserving the use of patadyong. Thus, through this ordinance, the Local Government Unit of Tigbauan is mandated to strategize to include Tigbauan Patadyong in the design of one of its official uniforms.

International and national agencies and offices, educational institutions from preschool to tertiary education, and establishments such as resorts, businesses, and a like, which buildings, offices, and facilities, are constructed and located within the jurisdiction of the municipality are also encouraged to do the same.

PROMOTION & USE OF TIGBAUAN PATADYONG

SECTION 8. SUKSUK PATADYONG. All educational institutions, local, national, and international agencies and offices, and establishments are enjoined to participate in a ceremonial wearing of patadyong, or a piece of clothing accented or inspired by Tigbauan Patadyong in celebration of the Tigbauan Devotional Fiesta every January and all other activities in the municipality.

SECTION 9. TIGBAUAN PATADYONG WEAVERS AND DESIGNERS. Local Weavers shall be organized, recognized or accredited, and empowered through a series of training, seminars, and participation on various international, national, regional, and local exhibits. Local designers shall be encouraged to use and promote Tigbauan Patadyong on their designs.

SECTION 10. DISPLAY OF TIGBAUAN PATADYONG. Locally woven patadyong must be displayed and accessible in Municipal Pasalubong Centers, Barangay Pasalubong Centers, and Tigbauan Public Market.

SECTION 11. TIGBAUAN PATADYONG I.E.C. MATERIALS. Information, Education, and Communication Materials introducing Patadyong as Municipal Textile must be displayed and accessible in government offices, barangay halls/bulletin boards, educational institutions, and establishments in the whole Municipality of Tigbauan.

Other activities that may be deemed of great contribution in the promotion of Tigbauan Patadyong may also be conducted.

SECTION 12. BUDGET ALLOCATION – Subject to the availability of funds, two hundred thousand pesos (P200,000.00) shall be allocated for the implementation of the ordinance. One hundred thousand pesos (P100,000.00) of which shall be allocated for the needs in the improvements and development of the weavers such as equipment and training, and another one hundred thousand pesos (P100,000.00) shall be allocated for the implementation of marketing strategies. The Local Government Unit may decide to improve these amounts in the succeeding years.

SECTION 13. REPEALING CLAUSE. All resolutions, ordinances and executive issuances or provisions thereof, which are inconsistent with any of the provisions hereof are hereby accordingly repealed, amended and/or modified.

SECTION 14. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Should any provision of this ordinance be subsequently declared unconstitutional or ultra vires, the rest of the provisions not so declared shall remain to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 15. **EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after posting in conspicuous places.
