RESOLUTION MAKING MANDATORY THE RULE THAT ANONYMOUS LETTERS, OR LETTERS SIGNED BY MARKS OR ALIASES, OR SIGNATURES APPARENTLY COMING FROM SPURIOUS SOURCES, OR VERBAL COMPLAINTS, THAT INSULT OR ASSASSINATE THE PERSONS OR CHARACTERS OF SANGGUNIAN MEMBERS, OFFICIALS OR EMPLOYEES OF THIS LGU, OR ANY PRIVATE CITIZEN FOR THAT MATTER, SHALL NOT BE CALENDARED AND/OR DELIBERATED UPON BY THIS SANGGUNIANG BAYAN

WHEREAS, this Honorable Sangguniang Bayan shall not entertain any verbal complaint unless properly reduced in writing and duly signed, or letters appearing to come from doubtful sources, or signed by questionable marks and aliases;

WHEREAS, there are unsigned letters that seek to disparage the persons and characters of S.B. Members, or insult the Sanggunian as a legislative body, or besmirch the honor and reputation of Members thereof;

WHEREAS, the above-stated unsigned letters, or signed by apparently fictitious or non-existent persons, once discussed and integrated into the Minutes of the Sanggunian, assumes the semblance of public documents, which should never be the case;

WHEREAS, if these letters become part and parcel of the Sanggunian Minutes, these can be used for "black propaganda" purposes against any candidate during election time;

NOW, THEREFORE, upon Motion of HON. ROMEO T. LEDESMA, Chairman, Committee on Good Government, Public Ethics, Accountability and Civil Service and duly seconded by Hon. Remedios Torrato and Hon. Agaton Tumabotabo, Be It

RESOLVED, as we hereby resolve, to Make Mandatory the Rule that Anonymous Letters, or Letters Signed by Marks or Aliases, or Signatures Apparently coming from Spurious Sources, or Verbal complaints, that Insult or Assassinate the Persons or Characters of Sanggunian Members, Officials or employees of this LGU, or any Private Citizen for that Matter, shall not be Calendared and/or Deliberated upon by this Sangguniang Bayan,

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to integrate the Title/Principle of this Resolution into the Internal Rules of this Sangguniang Bayan.
