Resolution No. 2009-037

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE TO LOOK AND NEGOTIATE FOR THE CONTRACT OF LEASE WITH ANY INTERESTED PARTY FOR THE CONTINUED OPERATION OF GASOLINE REFILLING STATION IN THE PARCEL OF LAND OWNED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIGBAUAN, PROVINCE OF ILOILO LOCATED AT CORNER TUPAS-TUPAN STREETS (BESIDE THE RURAL HEALTH UNIT)

WHEREAS, Chevron Philippines, the corporation that previously operated a gasoline refilling station in the Municipality of Tigbauan under the name CALTEX, had ceased operation in consonance with the expiration of the Contract of Lease executed before;

WHEREAS, Chevron Philippines was given up to June 30, 2009 to iron out all requirements for the turning over of the parcel of land to the municipality free from all sort of environmental problems;

WHEREAS, the closure of the Caltex Gasoline Refilling Station located at corner Tupas-Tupan Streets, Tigbauan, Iloilo brought a unified action of the different tricycle owners and drivers associations operating within the Municipality of Tigbauan specifically the Parara-Buyu-an Tricycle Owners and Drivers Association (PBTODA); Poblacion-Jamog Tricycle Owners and Drivers Association (TTODA); Samahan ng Tigbauan-Cordova Tricycle Owners and Drivers Association (STCTODA); and Tigbauan Econobike Owners and Drivers Association (TEDOA). The said tricycle owners and drivers associations are requesting the Office of the Mayor to continue the operation of a gas refilling station at the old site (vacated by the Caltex Gasoline Refilling Station) in their petition letter dated March 23, 2009.

WHEREAS, the above-cited tricycle owners and drivers associations anchored their request on the danger of using the national highway particularly the two (2) operational gasoline refilling stations located in Brgy. Namocon, this municipality and in Bantayan, Guimbal which is violative of the national law on using the national highways for tricycles (particularly out-of-route) and additional expenses will be incurred for the gas since the areas are quite too far;

WHEREAS, upon dubious scrutiny and study of the complaints by the tricycle owners and drivers associations and considering their grounds, the concerned committees to which this matter was referred to found out that the use of the National Roads could place the petitioners in great danger (on their lives and limbs) and the commuters as well as subsidiary financial liability for the owner in case an accident happens. Attached is the Committee Report rendered by the Committee on Transportation, Communication and Energy..

WHEREAS, the re-opening of the refilling site vacated by Chevron Philippines will benefit 95% of the tricycle owners and drivers associations operating in the Municipality of Tigbauan;

WHEREAS, to boost economic flow to the municipal coffer, it is considered advantageous to the municipality to continue renting out the site rather than leaving it idle as funds for the planned rehabilitation of the Rural Health Unit is yet to be sourced out;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of **HON. NORBERTO TURALBA, Chairman, Committee on Transportation, Communication and Energy, (Co-sponsored by HON. JOSE T. TAVARRO, JR., Chairman, Committee on Rules, Ordinances and Resolutions)** and duly seconded by Hon. Suzette Marie Hilado-Banno, Hon. Agaton Tumabotabo, Hon. Jose Tavarro, Jr., Hon. Loreta Lungay-Arias and Hon. Elmer Torrato,

RESOLVED, to authorize the Local Chief Executive To Look And Negotiate For The Contract Of Lease With Any Interested Party For The Continued Operation Of Gasoline Refilling Station In The Parcel of Land Owned By The Municipality Of Tigbauan, Province Of Iloilo Located At Corner Tupas-Tupan Streets (Beside The Rural Health Unit),

RESOLVED FURTHER to furnish copies of this Resolution to the Office of the Municipal Mayor and to all concerned for their information.
