RESOLUTION CONFORMING AND ADOPTING MDC-EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE RESOLUTION NO. 2014-001 "RESOLUTION REPROGRAMMING THE AMOUNT OF NINETY THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY PESOS (P 90,750.00) FOR SPECIAL PROGRAM FOR EMPLOYMENT OF STUDENTS AND THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FIVE PESOS (P 25,305.00) FOR COMPUTER LITERACY PROGRAM FROM VARIOUS BALANCES OF THE 20% CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS AS OF DECEMBER 31, 2013.

WHEREAS, the MDC Executive Committee (MDC-ExeCom) in its meeting last March 20, 2014 at the Office of the Mayor passed Resolution No. 2014-001, reprogramming various balances of the 20% Continuing Appropriations as of December 31, 2013;

WHEREAS, some balances of the 20% Continuing Appropriations reprogrammed under the aforementioned MDC-ExeCom Resolution No. 2014-001 have been outstanding since December 31, 2012 or earlier, and are inactive accounts in the Trial Balance which could be better utilized for relevant priority programs of the municipality;

WHEREAS, the amount of Ninety Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (P 90,750.00) was reprogrammed for the Special Program for the Employment of Students, as counterpart and in consonance with the summer employment program for the youth of the Department of Labor and Employment;

WHEREAS, the amount of Twenty Five Thousand Three Hundred Five Pesos (P 25,305.00) was reprogrammed for Computer Literacy Program, for honoraria of training instructors, consistent with the objective of enhancing the computer skills and competence of selected various employees and constituents;

WHEREAS, the utilization of funds under MDC-ExeCom Resolution No. 2014-001 aims to enhance the economic prosperity and full employment the people and the development of appropriate and self reliant scientific and technological capabilities of

the constituents, for which local governments are mandated to pursue under the Section 16 (General Welfare) of the Local Government Code;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of HON. RENEE LIBRODO-VALENCIA, *Chairperson, Committee on Appropriations* and duly seconded by Hon. Jose Donel Trasporto, Hon. Ricky Nulada, Hon. Ariel Bernardo and Hon. Ronnie Paguntalan,

RESOLVED, to adopt and conform MDC - Executive Committee Resolution No. 2014-001 Reprogramming Ninety Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (P 90,750.00) for Special Program for Employment of Students and Twenty Five Thousand Three Hundred Five (P 25,305.00) for Computer Literacy Program from various balances of the 20% Continuing Appropriations as of December 31, 2013;
