Resolution No. 2014 - 136

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR, ATTY. SUZETTE TENEFRANCIA-ALQUISADA FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIGBAUAN TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT FIELD OFFICE VI FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOOD PROGRAM (SLP).

WHEREAS, Article XII, Section 1 of the Philippine Constitution provides that “the goals of the national economy are a more equitable distribution of opportunities, income and wealth...and expanding productivity as the key to raising the quality of life for all especially the underprivileged”;

WHEREAS, Article XIII, Section 2 of the Philippine Constitution provides that the promotion of social justice shall include the commitment to create economic opportunities based on freedom of initiative and self-reliance;

WHEREAS, Section 3 of Republic Act 5416 otherwise known as the Social Welfare Act mandates DSWD to provide a comprehensive program of social welfare services designed to ameliorate the living conditions of distressed Filipino especially those who are handicapped by reason of poverty;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the above mandate the DSWD has designated the Sustainable Livelihood Program (SLP) which focuses on the promotion of viable people organizations that effectively address the livelihood needs of the disadvantaged groups;

WHEREAS, RA 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code provides for the consultation and coordination with Local Government Units (LGUs) on any project of the National Government Agencies (NGAs);

WHEREAS, the SLP is an innovative approach to livelihood development and people empowerment;

WHEREAS, all the parties believe that the partnership of the program beneficiaries, LGUs and the national government agency is necessary to contrive success in project implementation;

WHEREAS, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises. By mutual consent, the parties hereto do hereby agree to undertake the following:

1. The Department of Social Welfare and Development Field Office VI shall:

- 1.1 Provide the criteria for the identification of the area where the SLP will be implemented;
- 1.2 Provide eligibility standards for the identification of project beneficiaries;
- 1.3 Lead the implementation of the SLP in partnership with the assigned Social Welfare Officer (SWO) and/or Livelihood Worker;
- 1.4 Provide beneficiaries with value formation and business skills development trainings in coordination with the assigned SWO and/or Livelihood Worker;
- 1.5 Provide the capital seed fund for target household needing DSWD assistance;
- 1.6 Facilitate access of the SLP beneficiaries to other support services provided by other government agencies, non-government organizations, micro-finance institutions, private sector, business development service group, cooperatives, etc.
- 1.7 Monitor and evaluate the project in coordination with the Municipal Government through the Municipal Social Welfare office;
- 1.8 And undertake continuing building support to the beneficiaries.

2. The Local Government shall:

- 2.1 Promote the viability of the SLP beneficiaries' micro-enterprise projects;
- 2.2 Assign the SWO to assist the PDO II in the conduct of activities related to organizational development;
- 2.3 Assign a focal person and provide logistics support (transportation allowance, office supplies and materials, and communication funds) for SLP implementation;
- 2.4 Provide funds for the conduct of social preparation and capacity building activities;
- 2.5 Create favorable environment for micro enterprise development, like issuance of ordinance related thereto;
- 2.6 Establish linkages for related services to the beneficiaries at the local level in partnership with the DSWD field staff;
- 2.7 And join in the conduct of program monitoring and evaluation.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of HON. MA. GERRYLIN SANTUYO-CAMPOSAGRADO, *Chairperson, Committee on Education, Women & Family, Social Services and Senior Citizens* and duly seconded by Hon. Virgilio Teruel, Hon. Suzette Marie Hilado-Banno, Hon. Ricky Nulada, Hon. Ariel Bernardo and Hon. Ronnie T. Paguntalan,

RESOLVED, to authorize the Municipal Mayor, Atty. Suzette Tenefrancia-Alquisada For And In Behalf Of The Municipality Of Tigbauan To Enter Into A Memorandum Of Agreement With The Department Of Social Welfare And Development Field Office Vi For The Implementation Of Sustainable Livelihood Program (SLP),
