RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MAYOR SUZETTE TENEFRANCIA-ALQUISADA TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF TIGBAUAN WITH JOHN B. LACSON MARITIME UNIVERSITY-AREVALO, INC. AND DEPED-ILOILO DIVISION FOR THE CONTINUATION OF BUSOG, LUSOG, TALINO (BLT) FEEDING PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Area Implementing Partner envisions that every Filipino is able to access basic community services and live a life defined by dignity, purpose and active participation in nation-building;

WHEREAS, the Area Implementing Partner aims to contribute to the mitigation of hunger which attributes to cause low school attendance and high drop-out rates among Kinder 1, Grade 1, to 6 pupils in public elementary schools, through Jollibee Foundation's in-school feeding initiative dubbed as ***"Busog, Lusog, Talino" Program*** (the "Program");

WHEREAS, the Area Implementing Partner, LGU-Partner, and DepEd-Partner recognize the need to improve the nutritional status of undernourished public elementary pupils for them to have better chances of continuing their education;

WHEREAS, the parties seek to cooperate to undertake the implementation of the Program for the period August 1, 2013 to May 31, 2016;

WHEREAS, in consideration of the foregoing premises and of mutual covenants herein set forth, the parties agree as follows:

1. The Program

This Agreement outlines the details of the Program to be implemented between AREA IMPLEMENTING PARTNER, TIGBAUAN, ILOILO- LGU, and DEPED-ILOILO.

A comprehensive feeding and parents' education program shall be implemented for 120 school days per school year in (2) public elementary schools in Tigbauan, Iloilo for the benefit of pupils in Kinder, first to six grade the total of which should not be less than 15 and not to exceed 40 pupils per school.

2. Program Duration

*The Program duration shall be for three (3) years beginning **June 1, 2013 to May 31, 2016**;*

3. Program Financing

3.1 The total program cost for this year's effectivity of this Agreement is Ninety Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty Pesos (P90,720.00). Of this amount, the AREA IMPLEMENTING PARTNER shall provide a total of Forty Five Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Pesos (P45,360.00). The amount of Forty Five Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Pesos (45,360.00) will be provided by LGU-PARTNER in the form of cash or non-cash support.

3.2 The amount of Forty Five Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Pesos (P45,360.00) shall be provided by the AREA IMPLEMENTING PARTNER to LGU- TIGBAUAN, ILOILO based on the following schedule of payments:

<i>1st release</i>	30% of Forty Five Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Pesos (P45,360.00)	Upon submission of the: ➤ Final Master list of BLT Pupils ➤ School Affidavit of Undertaking ➤ Certificate of Physical /Medical Exam and De-worming
<i>2nd release</i>	30% of Forty Five Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Pesos (P45,360.00)	Upon completion of 30 feeding days and submission of the: ➤ Certificate of Completion of 30 Feeding Days
<i>3rd release</i>	30% of Forty Five Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Pesos (P45,360.00)	Upon completion of at least 60 feeding days and submission of the: ➤ Certificate of Completion of 60 Feeding Days ➤ Deed of Acceptance ➤ BLT Report Card: Summary of BLT Achievements (Mid-year) ➤ Financial Report Summary (Mid-year)
<i>4th release</i>	Remaining balance based (10%) of the Forty Five Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Pesos (P45,360.00)	Upon completion of 100 feeding days and submission of the: ➤ Certificate of Completion of 100 Feeding Days ➤ Resource Mobilization Plan

3.3 Total program cost for the succeeding years will be determined by the total number of BLT pupils per year; provided, however, that this should not exceed 40 pupils per school.

3.4 The AREA IMPLEMENTING PARTNER, and LGU- PARTNER, and DEPED-PARTNER shall execute a Letter of Agreement on the succeeding years until May 31, 2017 to indicate their concurrence on the annual budget.

4. Functions and Responsibilities

4.1 The AREA IMPLEMENTING PARTNER shall:

- 4.1.1 Approve final roster of BLT schools;
- 4.1.2 Provide financial support to the program and oversee the release of funds to LGU-TIGBAUAN for the effective implementation of the Program.
- 4.1.3 Provide technical support and information materials to LGU-TIGBAUAN and DEPED-ILOILO and the participating schools in the management of the Program.
- 4.1.4 Conduct capacity-building interventions for the LGU-TIGBAUAN and, DEPED-ILOILO in support of their program management functions.
- 4.1.5 Mobilize other agencies and resource organizations that would be needed to ensure the achievement of the objectives of the Program.

4.2 LGU- TIGBAUAN shall:

- 4.2.1 *Be financially accountable to the **AREA IMPLEMENTING PARTNER** for the funds to be provided to cover the cost of the feeding program. For this purpose, the **LGU- TIGBAUAN** shall:*
 - a. *Maintain a separate book of accounts for the program that is checked and verified by the accountant.*
- 4.2.2 *Contribute cash or non-cash support to the program in the form of technical assistance in the conduct of program implementation monitoring and evaluation.*
- 4.2.3 *Assign qualified personnel to regularly monitor schools.*
- 4.2.4 *Oversee the implementation of the feeding cycle activities which include the following:*
 - a. *Selection of program sites and partners*
 - b. *Orientation of partners*
 - c. *Selection of schools and pupils*
 - d. *School orientation*
 - e. *De-worming and physical check-up of pupils*
 - f. *Daily lunch feeding*
 - g. *Conduct of parent seminars*
 - h. *Monthly weighing of pupils*
 - i. *Program monitoring and evaluation*
- 4.2.5 *Consolidate pre-feeding, midyear and year-end requirements and reports of schools for submission to the **AREA IMPLEMENTING PARTNER**.*
- 4.2.6 *Lead in the development and implementation of program sustainability strategies such as, but not limited to, LGU advocacy, business sector partnerships and community fund-raising.*

4.3 DEPED PARTNER shall:

- 4.3.1 *Assist **LGU-PARTNER** in overseeing the implementation of the feeding cycle activities.*
- 4.3.2 *Assign qualified personnel to monitor the schools.*
- 4.3.3 *Conduct spot checking of schools' financial records.*
- 4.3.4 *Assist **LGU-PARTNER** in consolidating pre-feeding, midyear and year-end requirements and reports of schools for submission to the **AREA IMPLEMENTING PARTNER** and **JOLLIBEE GROUP FOUNDATION**.*
- 4.3.5 *Assist the schools in doing resource mobilization for BLT sustainability.*
- 4.3.6 *Share the program learning to other Divisions and schools and explore possible replication.*
- 4.3.7 *Acknowledge **JOHN B. LACSON FOUNDATION MARITIME UNIVERSITY-AREVALO** as the **BLT AREA IMPLEMENTING PARTNER** and **JOLLIBEE FOUNDATION** as the main donor and partner in the Program.*

5. No Employer-Employee Relationship

*In no way shall the **AREA IMPLEMENTING PARTNER** be construed as the employer of the employees of the **LGU-PARTNER**, **DEPED-PARTNER** or of any of the participants of the Program, such employees and participants being under the sole control and supervision of **LGU-PARTNER**, **DEPED-PARTNER** for the entire duration of their participation in the Program.*

6. Indemnity

LGU-PARTNER and DEPED-PARTNER shall hold the **FOUNDATION** and the **AREA IMPLEMENTING PARTNER** free and harmless from, and shall fully indemnify them against, any and all claims, damages, liabilities and costs (including legal fees) arising from or in connection with:

- 6.1 *Claims by any participant, employee or representative of the **LGU-PARTNER and DEPED PARTNER** based on an assertion of the existence of an employee-employer relationship between such party and the **FOUNDATION** and the **AREA IMPLEMENTING PARTNER (AIP)**.*
- 6.2 *Claims arising out of physical injury, disability, loss, damage, or death sustained or suffered or caused by any employee or representative of the **LGU- PARTNER and DEPED**-*

- 6.3 *Claims arising out of physical injury, disability, loss, damage, or death sustained or suffered or caused by any participant or beneficiary of the Program;*
- 6.4 *Claims arising out of physical injury, disability, loss, damage, or death sustained or suffered or caused by any third party other than in connection with the fault or gross negligence of the AIP and the FOUNDATION.*

7. Amendment

This agreement may be amended and modified from time to time, in writing, signed, sealed and acknowledged by the parties which amendments and modifications shall then be attached to the original of this instrument.

8. Termination

This agreement may be terminated by either party prior to the expiration thereof, in whole or in part, if both parties agree that the continuation of the Program would not produce beneficial results. Both parties shall agree upon the termination, conditions, including the effective date, and in the case of partial termination, the portion to be terminated.

Lacson Maritime University-Arevalo, Inc. And DEPED-Iloilo Division For The Continuation Of Busog, Lusog, Talino (BLT) Feeding Program,
