RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE EXEMPLARY PERFORMANCE OF TIGBAUANON PARAW SAILORS DURING THE 43RD PARAW REGATTA COMPETITION HELD LAST FEBRUARY 20-22, 2015 AT STO. NIÑO SUR, AREVALO, ILOILO CITY.

WHEREAS, Paraw Regatta is considered as the oldest traditional sailboat event in Asia and the biggest traditional sailing boat competition in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, Paraw Regatta competition is held annually in the strait separating Iloilo and the Island Province of Guimaras;

WHEREAS, during the *43rd Paraw Regatta Competition* held last February 20-22, 2015, 50 paraw – type sailboats participated in the Slalom (Short Course) and Long Distance Course in three (3) categories: Category A sailboat with waterline of 16 feet and below, Category B sailboat with waterline of 16.1 feet to 22 feet and Category C sailboat with waterline of 22.1 feet and above;

WHEREAS, the craftsmanship and skills in maneuvering a paraw-type sailboat of the Tigbauanons were duly recognized and awarded in this biggest sailboat event;

WHEREAS, Sailboat “CHERYL” of MR. FEDERICO TANTIADO, JR. of Brgy. Parara Sur, Tigbauan, Iloilo was declared CHAMPION in the Long Distance Course and 2nd Place in the Slalom for Category C;

WHEREAS, Sailboat “MITCH ANGEL” of MICHAEL ANTHONY TANGUB of Brgy. Poblacion 1, Tigbauan, Iloilo garnered 3rd Place in Long Distance Course and 2nd place in the Slalom for Category A;

WHEREAS, Sailboat “SHANE AND SHARMAINE” of NELSON GUZMAN of Brgy. Parara Sur, Tigbauan, Iloilo won the 3rd place in Long Distance Course for Category C;

WHEREAS, the achievement of these Tigbauanon Paraw Sailors made our Municipality known as EXCELLENT builders and sailors for a paraw-type sailboats and they are worthy to be recognized and emulated as a good example to be followed;
