Resolution No. 2016-080

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR, ATTY. SUZETTE TENEFRANCIA-ALQUISADA, FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIGBAUAN, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE CENTER FOR HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONS CEBU, INC. FOR THE CONDUCT OF TRAINING AND COMPETENCY ASSESSMENT ON EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES NCII.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan Office has received an urgent letter dated August 10, 2016 of the Honorable Mayor Suzette Tenefrancia-Alquisada requesting for the passage of a "*Resolution Authorizing the Municipal Mayor, Atty. Suzette Tenefrancia-Alquisada, for and in Behalf of the Municipality of Tigbauan, to Enter Into a Memorandum of Agreement With the Center for Healthcare Professions Cebu, Inc. for the Conduct of Training and Competency Assessment on Emergency Medical Services NCII*";

WHEREAS, this Memorandum of Agreement will be entered into by the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Operation Center, this municipality thru Hon. Suzette Tenefrancia-Alquisada, Municipal Mayor referred to as the **First Party**, and the Center for Healthcare Professions Cebu, Inc. thru its President, Mr. Bernard C. Restificar referred to as the **Second Party**;

WHEREAS, both parties are willing to cooperate for the training programs, opportunity for employment and conduct of competency assessment of the **SECOND PARTY** on the Emergency Medical Services NCII qualifications as enumerated in **ANNEX "A"** of this resolution (*Re: Sec. 1 of TRAINING REGULATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES NCII*);

WHEREAS, for and in consideration of the above, the parties hereby agree to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement for the Conduct of Training and Competency Assessment on Emergency Medical Services NCII under the following terms and conditions:

A. **That the FIRST PARTY shall:**

1. Provide maximum opportunity for trainees and/ assesses to gain experience in training and assessment, utilizing available materials and equipment of the institution, without impairing its services to clients, including but not limited to ambulance, training and assessment venues and possible accommodation for trainers;

2. Identify and endorse pre-qualified participants to the mobile training programs;
3. Enforce the training rules and regulations upholding the conduct of skills training and competency assessment;
4. Take disciplinary measures or terminate the Practicum of any trainee/assesse who fails to comply with the regulations of the institution or who commits acts detrimental to the health, safety and welfare of its clients and personnel;
5. Not to be held liable in case of accidents happening to trainees/assesses or anything untoward that may transpire during training hours and conduct of competency assessment;
6. Not to be held liable for the whereabouts of the trainees/assesses in case of the latter's absences;
7. Provide maximum opportunity for employment after graduating from the training program and being assessed and certified competent by TESDA.

B. That the SECOND PARTY shall:

1. Submit to the FIRST PARTY a list of all the trainees who shall be assigned for On-the-Job Training or Supervised Industry Training together with their assigned schedule covering hours as set in the training program or as so required;
2. Coordinate with industry partners to issue a certificate of OJT completion;
3. Ensure that all trainees assigned to the FIRST PARTY will comply with the training rules and regulations of the institution;
4. Provide for didactic instructions of trainees as required;
5. Reimburse the institution either in cash or in kind for all losses or breakage of equipment as a result of the carelessness or negligence of its trainees;
6. Issue a training certificate for each participant as identified and endorsed by the FIRST PARTY upon completion of training which includes mandatory competency assessment.

C. General Policies

1. At no time shall the interest and welfare of clients be subordinate to the conduct of the affiliation during the training and conduct of competency assessment.
2. All trainees shall be governed by rules and regulations regarding the conduct of training prescribed by the First Party or his duly authorized representative.

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of **HON. JULIUS T. LEDESMA** (*under the sponsorship of Hon. Suzette Marie Hilado-Banno, Chairperson Committee on Health and Sanitation*) and duly seconded by Hon. Dennis T. Valencia, Hon. John Gershwin C. Tueres, Hon. Ariel I. Bernardo, Hon. Neri T. Camiña, Hon. Ma. Gerrylin Santuyo-Camposagrado, Hon. Jerry Tuares and Hon. Ronnie T. Paguntalan,

RESOLVED, to authorize the Municipal Mayor, Atty. Suzette Tenefrancia-Alquisada, for and in behalf of the Municipality of Tigbauan, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Center for Healthcare Professions Cebu, Inc. for the conduct of Training and Competency Assessment on Emergency Medical Services NCII.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to forward copies of this Resolution to the Office of the Municipal Mayor, this municipality, to Mr. Bernard C. Restificar, Administrator, Center for Healthcare Professions Cebu, Inc. and to all concerned for their information and/or appropriate action.
