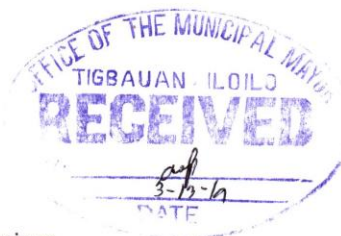

**Resolution No. 2019-027**

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CONDUCT OF MEASLES VACCINATION AND VITAMIN A SUPPLEMENTATION ACTIVITY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (DOH) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIGBAUAN, PROVINCE OF ILOILO.

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2019, the Department of Health Center for Health Western Visayas issued Advisory No. 3 s. 2019 with the subject: "Intensified Measles Outbreak Response Immunization in Western Visayas;"

WHEREAS, in January to December 2018, there were 21,812 reported measles cases with 202 deaths; out of the total suspected cases, 70% have not been immunized with measles and 29% has unknown vaccination status. This proves that a significant susceptible population particularly children below 5 years of age are still unvaccinated, hence at risk of getting infected with measles;

WHEREAS, Measles is an acute viral respiratory illness characterized by fever and malaise (feeling of general discomfort), cough, coryza (runny nose), and conjunctivitis (red eyes), skin rashes lasting more than three (3) days. It is transferred from person to person by sneezing, coughing and close personal contact. Patients are considered to be contagious from four (4) days before to four (4) days after the rash appears;

WHEREAS, with the declaration of measles outbreak and the increasing number of reported cases, the DOH Center for Health Western Visayas has already detected 428 measles cases with three (3) deaths from January 1-February 12, 2019;

WHEREAS, this increase in cases and alarming mortality calls for an aggressive and harmonized outbreak response to immediately and effectively interrupt the transmission of the measles virus in the region;

WHEREAS, as such, the following are to expound the recommended Outbreak Response Immunization (ORI) strategies that shall be immediately conducted within February-April 2019:

- 1) Selective Catch-up Vaccination for MR OPV SIA Phase-1 (CY 2018) 32 LGUs
- 2) Non-Selective Vaccination for MR SIA 2019 Phase-2
- 3) School Based Immunization
- 4) Vaccination of other Vulnerable Age-groups
- 5) Provision of Vitamin A Supplementation
  - a) Vitamin A supplementation may be given during the Catch-up and Non-Selective vaccination following age-appropriate dosing and interval.

AGE	VITAMIN A DOSAGE
6-11 months	100,000 IU
12-59 months	200,000 IU

WHEREAS, to efficiently and safely manage the region-wide vaccination operations and logistics requirement during the campaign, LGUs shall always observe the standards in safe-injection and vaccine cold-chain management; and shall likewise consider the prioritization in the provision of vaccination opportunities among vulnerable age-cohorts in the following order:

1. Unvaccinated under five-year old children
2. Defaulters for Grades 1 & Grade 7 learners
3. Public health workers and hospital facility staff
4. Unvaccinated close contacts of identified measles cases
5. Unvaccinated Grade 2 to 6 learners
6. Unvaccinated adults who voluntarily submit for vaccination
