RESOLUTION DECLARING AS **LEGAL** AND **VALID** BARANGAYS CORDOVA SUR, LANAG, OLO BARROC AND SERMON ORDINANCES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIGBAUAN, PROVINCE OF ILOILO.

WHEREAS, Brgys. Cordova Sur, Lanag, Olo Barroc and Sermon Councils submitted to this August Body their ordinances for review and recommendation, to wit:

Brgy. Cordova Sur Ordinance No. 03-2018- "An Ordinance Regulating The Operation Of Computer Shops (Internet Shops) Operating At Barangay Cordova Sur, Municipality Of Tigbauan, Province Of Iloilo And Providing Penalties In Violation Thereof;"

Brgy. Lanag Revenue Ordinance No. 2019-001- "An Ordinance Adopting The Barangay Revenue Code Of Barangay Lanag, Municipality Of Tigbauan, Province Of Iloilo."

Brgy. Olo Barroc Ordinance No. 2018-001- "An Ordinance Regulating and Declaring the Inside of the Covered Gym of the Barangay Olo Barroc, Tigbauan, Iloilo as No Parking Zone for Public and Privately Owned Vehicle and Providing Penalties in Violation Thereof."

Brgy. Sermon Ordinances:

a. **No. 2019-001-** "An Ordinance For Tax Collection For Livelihood Within The Barangay And Other Barangay Collections."

b. **No. 2019-002-** "An Ordinance Prohibiting The Loosely Grazing Of Large Cattle And Other Hoofed Animals In Any Places Around The Barangay And Other Prohibitions About These Animals."

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned Ordinances of said Barangays were referred to the Committee on Rules, Ordinances, Resolutions & Legal Matters chaired by Vice-Mayor, Atty. Virgilio T. Teruel, and after careful study, the committee has come up with the following findings:

"The ordinances were presented in a barangay assembly on the following dates: **Brgy. Cordova Sur on October 14, 2018; Brgy. Lanag on December 25, 2018; Brgy. Olo Barroc on December 29, 2018 and Brgy. Sermon on January 13, 2019** and are consistent with the provisions of Section 391 of the Local Government Code, to wit:

SECTION 391. Powers, Duties and Functions. – (a) The sangguniang barangay, as the legislative body of the barangay, shall:

- (1) Enact ordinances as may be necessary to discharge the responsibilities conferred upon it by law and ordinance and to promote the general welfare of the inhabitants therein;
- (2) Enact tax and revenue ordinances, subject to the limitations imposed in this Code;
- (7) Regulate the use of multi-purpose halls, multi-purpose pavements, grains or copra dryers, patios and other post-harvest facilities, Barangay waterworks, Barangay markets, parking areas of other similar facilities constructed with government funds within the jurisdiction of the Barangay and charge reasonable fees for the use thereof;
- (14) Prescribe fines in amounts not exceeding One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) for violation of barangay ordinances;
- (24) Exercise such other powers and perform such duties and functions as maybe prescribed by law or ordinance;

WHEREAS, these ordinances were also consistent with SECTION 16 of the LGC which provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied there from, as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;


NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of HON. MA. GERRYLIN SANTUYO-CAMPOSAGRADO Committee Vice Chairperson, (under the sponsorship of VICE MAYOR, ATTY. VIRGILIO T. TERUEL, Chairman, Committee on Rules, Ordinances, Resolutions and Legal Matters) and duly seconded by Hon. Dennis T. Valencia, Hon. John Gershwin C. Tueres, Hon. Bernardo, Hon. Neri T. Camiña, Hon. Suzette Marie Hilado-Banno, Hon. Ricky T. Nulada, Hon. Jerry T. Tuares and Hon. Dyossa Marie Teruñez;

RESOLVED, to declare as **Legal** and **Valid** Barangays Cordova Sur, Lanag, Olo Barroc and Sermon Ordinances of the Municipality of Tigbauan, Province of Iloilo;
