RESOLUTION REQUESTING FROM THE NATIONAL HISTORICAL COMMISSION FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION PESOS (P2,000,000.00) TO DEFRAY EXPENSES FOR REFURBISHING/RECONSTRUCTION AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE PANAY LANDING MEMORIAL IN VIEW OF THE CELEBRATION OF THE 75TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE LIBERATION OF THE ISLAND OF PANAY AND ROMBLON ON MARCH 18, 2020.

WHEREAS, on our shores, along Parara Beach, Tigbauan, Iloilo, landed on March 18, 1945, the 40th Infantry Division, 8th U.S. Army under Major General Rapp Brush. The Filipino forces under Colonel Macario Peralta, Jr. met them and jointly started operations for the liberation of the islands of Panay and Romblon;

WHEREAS, Mayor Eugenio T. Torrento, Sr. erected the Panay Liberation Marker at a junction to the beach along the National Highway of Brgy. Parara, Tigbauan, Iloilo to memorialize the event;

WHEREAS, the Panay Landing Memorial was erected in tribute to the landing of Major General Rapp Brush and his men on March 18, 1945 at Parara Beach, Tigbauan, in the Province of Iloilo. The Landing Memorial consists of concrete busts of Colonel Macario Peralta Jr., General Douglas MacArthur, and Lieutenant Colonel Julian Chaves on top of a ship inspired memorial;

WHEREAS, in 1954, the Philippine Historical Committee installed a memorial marker in remembrance of the men and women who fought for the Liberation of the Island of Panay from the Japanese Imperial Forces;

WHEREAS, it is but a moral obligation on the part of every citizen, specially the youth, to acknowledge the heroism and sacrifices of our Filipino soldiers, guerrillas and civilians who answered the call to duty and defended the country from foreign invasion during its dark days of the Second World War;

WHEREAS, to properly and honorably celebrate the 75th Anniversary of the Panay Landing or the Liberation of Panay and Romblon on March 18, 2020, there is a dire need of funds to refurbish and make improvements on the Panay Landing Memorial;

NOW, THEREFORE, upon motion of HON. MA. GERRYLIN SANTUYO-CAMPOSAGRADO, *Chairperson, Committee on Education, Tourism and Civil Service*, and duly seconded by Hon. Neri T. Camiña, Hon. Suzette Marie Hilado-Banno, Hon. Reynaldo E. Tumabotabo, Hon. Julius T. Ledesma, Hon. Norberto T. Turalba, Hon. Jerry T. Tuares and Hon. Dyossa Marie T. Teruñez,

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to pass a Resolution Requesting from the National Historical Commission of the Philippines Financial Assistance in the amount of Two Million Pesos (P2,000,000.00) to Defray Expenses for Refurbishing and Improvement of the Panay Landing Memorial in view of the Celebration of the 75th Anniversary of the Liberation of the Island of Panay and Romblon on March 18, 2020.
