RESOLUTION ADOPTING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11148, "AN ACT SCALING UP THE NATIONAL AND LOCAL HEALTH AND NUTRITION PROGRAMS THROUGH A STRENGTHENED INTEGRATED STRATEGY FOR MATERNAL, NEONATAL, CHILD HEALTH AND NUTRITION IN THE FIRST ONE THOUSAND (1,000) DAYS OF LIFE APPROPRIATING

WHEREAS, presented for consideration was Republic Act No. 11148 enacted by the Senate and House of Representative of the Philippines in Congress on July 23, 2018 known as "KALUSUGAN AT NUTRITION NG MAG-NANAY ACT;"

WHEREAS, it is hereby declared Policy the right to health is a fundamental principle guaranteed by the State. Section 15, Article 11 of the 1987 Constitution emphasizes that, "The State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them";

WHEREAS, pursuant to various international human rights instruments and agreements that the State adheres to, the State guarantees the right to adequate food, care and nutrition to pregnant and lactating mothers, including adolescent girls, women of reproductive age, and especially children from zero (0) to two (2) years old;

WHEREAS, the State further commits to the Philippine Development Plan and the national plan on nutrition to contribute to the improvement of the quality of human resource in the country, and the reduction of maternal and child mortality and stunting;

WHEREAS, one of the specific aims of this Act is to provide comprehensive, sustainable, multi-sectoral strategies and approaches to address health and nutrition problems of newborns, infants and young children, pregnant and lactating women and adolescent females, as well as multi-factorial issues that negatively affect the development of newborns, infants and young children, integrating the short, medium and long-term plans of the government to end hunger, improve health and nutrition, and reduce malnutrition.
