**Resolution No. 2022-032**

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING BINALIUAN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, BARROC NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, CORDOVA NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, BARROC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, BINALIUAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, NAMOCON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND TIGBAUAN CENTRAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL FOR THE OPENING OF THE EXPANDED LIMITED FACE TO FACE CLASSES IN THE SCHOOLS DISTRICT OF TIGBAUAN FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR 2021-2022.

WHEREAS, the Public Schools District Supervisor, Mr. Edmund M. Mirasol in his letter dated March 25, 2022 requested the Municipal Mayor, Atty. Suzette T. Alquisada for the issuance of a letter of support from her good office as well as the passing of a resolution of support from the Sangguniang Bayan. These documents are among the primary documentary requirements to be looked for by the Division Technical Working Group during the validation day;

WHEREAS, in the letters dated March 28 and 29, 2022 the Municipal Mayor requested this Sangguniang Bayan for the passing of resolutions, entitled: *“Resolution Supporting Binaliuan National High School and Barroc National High School for the Opening of the Expanded Limited Face to Face Classes in this Schools District for the School Year 2021-2022”* and *“Resolution Supporting Barroc Elementary School, Binaliuan Elementary School, Namoccon Elementary School, Tigbauan Central Elementary School and Cordova National High School for the Opening of the Expanded Limited Face to Face Classes in this Schools District for the School Year 2021-2022;”*

WHEREAS, Division Memorandum No. 038, S. 2021 was issued by Schools Division Superintendent, Roel F. Bermejo on February 24, 2022 (*to Assistant Schools Division Superintendents, Division Chiefs, Public Schools District Supervisors, Heads, Public Elementary, Integrated and Secondary Schools and Other concerned*) with the Subject: *“Submission of Recommended Schools for the Expanded Implementation of Limited Face-to-Face Classes”* preferably one (1) elementary school and one (1) secondary or integrated school to be submitted on or before February 28, 2022;

WHEREAS, DepEd Memorandum No. 071, s. 2021 was issued by DepEd Secretary, Leonor Magtolis Briones on October 15, 2021 (*to Undersecretaries, Assistant Secretaries, Bureau and Service Directors, Regional Directors, School Division Superintendents, Public and Private Schools and All Other Concerned*) with the Subject: *“Preparation for the Pilot Face-to-Face, Expansion and Transitioning to New Normal;”*

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte had approved on September 20, 2021 the joint proposal of DepEd and DOH for the conduct of pilot face-to-face classes in 100 public schools and 20 private schools, or a total of 120 schools nationwide;

WHEREAS, based on the Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, s. of 2021 signed by the Secretaries of DepEd and DOH, schools that will be included in the pilot phase must satisfy the following conditions: located in minimal risk area, secured LGU concurrence, passed the School Safety Assessment Tool (SSAT) (*enclosed to DepEd Memorandum No. 071, S. 2021*) and secured parent's consent;

WHEREAS, based on the shared responsibility indicators of the SSAT, one of the requirements is for the schools to secure support of the LGU (*Barangay, Municipality, City, Province*) through a resolution or a letter of support;

WHEREAS, the Tigbauan Schools District - Technical Assistance Team has recommended to the Division Office, Binaliuan National High School, Barroc National High School, Cordova National High School, Barroc Elementary School, Binaliuan Elementary School, Namoccon Elementary School and Tigbauan Central Elementary School for the validation of their preparations for the limited face-to-face classes;

WHEREAS, these schools were pre-validated by the District Technical Assistance Team and were found compliant with the indicators set by the DepEd;


NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of HON. NERI T. CAMIÑA, Chairman, S.B. Committee on Education, Tourism and Civil Service and duly seconded by Hon. Marlon R. Teruñez, Hon. Suzette Marie Hilado-Banno, Hon. Reynaldo E. Tumabotabo, Hon. Julius T. Ledesma, Hon. Ma. Gerrylin Santuyo-Camposagrado, Hon. Norberto T. Turalba, and Hon. Dyossa Marie T. Teruñez;

RESOLVED, to support Binaliuan National High School, Barroc National High School, Cordova National High School, Barroc Elementary School, Binaliuan Elementary School, Namoccon Elementary School and Tigbauan Central Elementary School for the Opening of the Expanded Limited Face to Face Classes in the Schools District of Tigbauan for the School Year 2021-2022;

RESOLVED FURTHER, to furnish copies of this Resolution to the Office of the Municipal Mayor, Atty. Suzette Tenefrancia-Alquisada, to the Office of the Public School Supervisor, Mr. Edmund M. Mirasol and to all concerned schools for their information and/or appropriate action.
