AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE ANNUAL CELEBRATION OF MUNICIPAL TEACHERS' DAY EVERY FIRST FRIDAY OF OCTOBER IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIGBAUAN, PROVINCE OF ILOILO, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

EXPLANATORY NOTES

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines recognizes the vital role of education in national development and mandates the State to give priority to education, science and technology, arts, culture, and sports to foster patriotism and nationalism, accelerate social progress, and promote total human liberation and development;

WHEREAS, teachers serve as key agents in nation-building, guiding learners, shaping values, and empowering communities through their dedication, compassion, and service;

WHEREAS, Presidential Proclamation No. 242 (s. 2011) declared September 5 to October 5 of every year as National Teachers' Month, while United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) declared October 5 as World Teachers' Day;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Tigbauan recognizes the indispensable contribution of its teachers - public, private, SPED, ALS, implementers, and mobile teachers—and deems it proper to institutionalize a local celebration in harmony with the National Teachers' Month framework;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Bayan is empowered to enact ordinances necessary to promote the general welfare of its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, institutionalizing the annual celebration of Municipal Teachers' Day will strengthen partnerships among schools, barangays, community organizations, and the Local Government Unit and will ensure a sustained, meaningful, and well-funded celebration honoring teachers;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Tigbauan, in session assembled, that:

 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.** This Ordinance shall be known as the ***"Municipal Teachers' Day Ordinance of Tigbauan, Iloilo"***.

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It is hereby declared the policy of the Municipality of Tigbauan to recognize, honor, and promote the welfare and professional advancement of teachers by institutionalizing an annual celebration aligned with national and international observances.

 **SECTION 3. COVERAGE.** This Ordinance shall cover all teachers residing, working, or serving within the Municipality of Tigbauan, including but not limited to:

- a. Public school teachers under the Department of Education (DepEd);
- b. Private school teachers;
- c. Non-formal education facilitators and Alternative Learning System (ALS) teachers;
- d. Daycare workers under the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO);
- e. Other teaching and non-teaching personnel directly involved in educational delivery.

SECTION 4. INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF MUNICIPAL TEACHERS' DAY. The Municipality of Tigbauan shall celebrate Municipal Teachers' Day every **first Friday of October** of each year.

SECTION 5. CREATION OF THE MUNICIPAL TEACHERS' DAY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE. There is hereby created the **Municipal Teachers' Day Executive Committee** to plan, organize, and supervise activities for the celebration, composed of but not limited to:

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- a. Municipal Mayor – Chairperson
 - b. SB Chairperson on Education – Co-Chairperson
 - c. Public Schools District Supervisor (PSDS) – Co-Chairperson
 - d. School Heads
 - e. Representatives from Public and Private Schools
 - f. Municipal Social Welfare and Development Officer – Member
 - g. SK Federation President – Member
 - h. ALS Representative – Member
 - i. CSO Representative – Member
 - j. Other stakeholders as may be designated by the Mayor

The Committee may create subcommittees as necessary.

SECTION 6. PROGRAMS, ACTIVITIES, AND PROJECTS. The Municipal Teachers' Day Celebration shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

- a. Opening ceremonies and recognition programs;
- b. Wellness, capacity-building, or professional development activities;

- c. Awarding of outstanding teachers, mentors, and education partners;
- d. Community events promoting the value of education and respect for teachers;
- e. Outreach or community service activities led by teachers and students; and
- f. Preparation of an Annual Work and Financial Plan (AWFP).

SECTION 7. FUNDING. An initial amount of THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P300,000.00) is hereby appropriated for the implementation of this Ordinance, which shall be included in the Annual Budget of the Municipality of Tigbauan under the Office of the Mayor or such other appropriate budgetary item.

The amount herein appropriated may be increased through supplemental budgets or subsequent annual appropriations, as may be deemed necessary. Additional funding may also be sourced from:

- a. Donations, sponsorships, or grants;
- b. Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) partnerships;
- c. Other lawful sources not contrary to existing laws, rules, and regulations.

All funds received and disbursed pursuant to this Ordinance shall be subject to existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

SECTION 8. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR). Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Ordinance, the Municipal Teachers' Day Executive Committee shall formulate and issue the necessary Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR).

SECTION 9. MONITORING AND EVALUATION. The Municipal Teachers' Day Executive Committee shall submit an annual report to the Sangguniang Bayan on the implementation, accomplishments, and utilization of funds.

SECTION 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 11. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, resolutions, or parts thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 12. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after compliance with posting and/or publication requirements.
