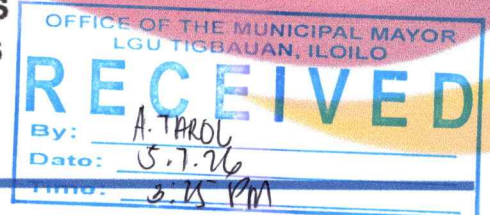

Municipal Ordinance No. 2026-008

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE MUNICIPAL GARBAGE COLLECTION SYSTEM IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIGBAUAN, PROVINCE OF ILOILO, ESTABLISHING A SEGREGATED COLLECTION SCHEDULE, PRESCRIBING COLLECTION ROUTES AND TIME, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES AND FUNDS FOR ITS IMPLEMENTATION

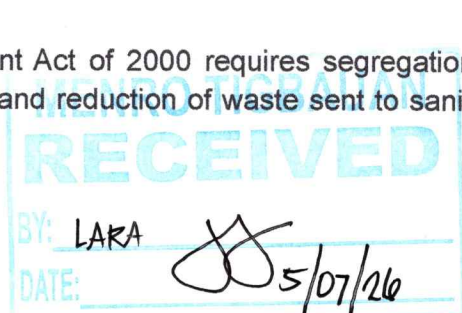

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates local government units to promote the general welfare, including environmental protection and sanitation;

WHEREAS, Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 requires segregation at source, establishment of an efficient collection system, and reduction of waste sent to sanitary landfills;



WHEREAS, the Municipality of Tigbauan recognizes the need to institutionalize a structured, efficient, and environmentally sound garbage collection system;

WHEREAS, a scheduled and segregated waste collection system promotes discipline, reduces landfill dependency, and strengthens circular economy practices;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Tigbauan, Iloilo, in session duly assembled:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the “Tigbauan Municipal Garbage Collection Ordinance of 2026.”

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It is hereby declared the policy of the Municipality of Tigbauan to:

- a. Ensure efficient, accessible, and regular waste collection services;
- b. Promote strict segregation at source;
- c. Minimize waste sent to sanitary landfill;
- d. Protect public health and the environment; and
- e. Support sustainable and circular waste management systems.

SECTION 3. COVERAGE. This Ordinance shall apply to all households, commercial establishments, institutions, and barangays within the Municipality of Tigbauan.

SECTION 4. PRIMARY AND AUXILIARY GARBAGE COLLECTION VEHICLE. To ensure efficient and uninterrupted garbage collection services, the Local Government Unit of Tigbauan shall assign the following vehicles:

- 1. The compactor truck shall serve as the primary vehicle for municipal garbage collection;
- 2. The canter truck shall serve as a backup or auxiliary vehicle, to be deployed in cases of overflow, equipment breakdown, special collection operations, or emergency situations;

The Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office shall oversee the scheduling, maintenance, and deployment of all garbage collection vehicles.

The LGU shall ensure that all vehicles are properly maintained, fueled, and equipped to carry out regular and special collection operations.

SECTION 5. SEGREGATED COLLECTION SCHEDULE. The Local Government Unit of Tigbauan, through the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office, shall adopt the following garbage collection schedule:

Monday	Disposal of all collected municipal waste to the sanitary landfill, no household collection
Tuesday	Plastic Waste
Wednesday	Paper Waste, Textiles, and Rubber
Thursday	Biodegradable Waste
Friday	Residual Waste, E-Waste, Medical Waste

Only properly segregated waste shall be collected on designated days.

SECTION 6. COLLECTION TIME. Garbage collection shall commence daily at 9:30 A.M.

Residents and establishments must place their waste at designated collection points at least 30 minutes before collection time.

SECTION 7. COLLECTION ROUTES The following routes shall be observed:

Route 1: Poblacion → Barroc → Poblacion

Route 2: Poblacion → Buyuan → Poblacion

Route 3: Poblacion → Cordova Norte → Poblacion

Route 4: Poblacion → Jamog → Poblacion

The MENRO may adjust routes as necessary for efficiency.

SECTION 8. NON-COLLECTION POLICY. Unsegregated or improperly disposed waste shall not be collected. The collector shall issue a notice of non-compliance against violators.

SECTION 9. MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE MANAGER. To strengthen coordination and implementation, the following positions are hereby institutionalized:

1. Municipal Solid Waste Manager (MSWM)
 - a. To be designated by the Municipal Mayor and shall operate under the MENRO;
 - b. Shall oversee the overall implementation of the garbage collection system;
 - c. Shall coordinate planning, monitoring, and reporting activities;
 - d. Shall serve as the primary link between the Municipality and barangays on solid waste management concerns.
2. Barangay Solid Waste Manager (BSWM)
 - a. Each barangay shall designate a Barangay Solid Waste Manager;
 - b. BSWM shall ensure compliance with waste segregation and collection schedules at the barangay level;
 - c. BSWM shall coordinate with the MSWM before, during, and after collection operations;
 - d. BSWM shall report issues such as non-compliance, missed collection, and waste accumulation.

SECTION 10. DIGITIZED GARBAGE COLLECTION REPORTING SYSTEM. A Digitized Garbage Collection Reporting System is hereby established to improve efficiency, transparency, and public access to waste management services. This system shall be monitored by the Municipal Solid Waste Manager.

The system shall:

1. Allow residents and establishments to report missed collections;
2. Facilitate requests for special or emergency garbage collection;
3. Provide a platform for reporting illegal dumping and other violations; and
4. Enable the MENRO to monitor collection performance in real time.

The MENRO shall ensure that all reports are logged, tracked, and acted upon promptly.

SECTION 11. INTER-BARANGAY COORDINATION AND CLUSTER SYSTEM. To ensure efficiency and inclusivity in waste management:

1. Barangays shall coordinate with neighboring barangays to harmonize waste collection, segregation, and disposal practices.
2. Barangays located in remote or hard-to-reach areas may form clusters for shared collection schedules and logistical support.
3. Where establishment of individual MRFs is not feasible, two or more barangays may establish and operate a shared MRF, subject to approval and supervision by the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO).
4. The MENRO shall facilitate coordination, provide technical assistance, and ensure equitable service delivery among clustered barangays.

SECTION 12. PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS FOR WASTE MANAGEMENT. To enhance efficiency and innovation, the Local Government Unit of Tigbauan may enter into partnerships with private entities, cooperatives, junk shops, and non-government organizations for:

- 1. Collection and processing of recyclable materials;
- 2. Operation of recycling facilities; and
- 3. Waste-to-resource initiatives

All partnerships shall be subject to applicable laws, rules, and regulations, ensuring transparency, accountability, and environmental compliance; Provided that the MENRO shall oversee and monitor all partnership agreements.

SECTION 13. APPROPRIATION. Funds necessary or incidental to the implementation of this ordinance shall be sourced from the Municipal Annual Budget, including the 20% Development Fund, and other available grants and partnerships, subject to the availability of funds and usual budgeting, accounting and auditing rules.

SECTION 14. MONITORING AND EVALUATION. The MENRO shall Monitor collection efficiency, track waste volume reduction, submit and present quarterly reports during the Solid Waste Management Council Regular Meetings.

SECTION 15. IMPLEMENTING OFFICE. The Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO) shall serve as the lead implementing and enforcement unit. Barangay officials and deputized environmental enforcers may monitor compliance, issue citation tickets, and report violations.

SECTION 14. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR). Within ninety (90) days from effectivity, the Buhin Basura Council shall formulate the IRR for the effective implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 12. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. The provisions of this Ordinance are separable, and in the event that any or more of such provisions are declared invalid, the validity of all other provisions shall not be affected hereby.

SECTION 13. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any Ordinance, Executive Orders and Local Issuance or Rules and Regulations or part thereof, inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed and or altered accordingly.

SECTION 14. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and compliance to the requirements of the Local Government Code.
