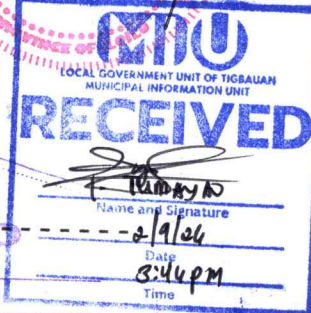

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR GREATER CONSISTENCY AND OBJECTIVITY IN THE LOCAL LEGISLATIVE AWARDS SEARCH-EVALUATION PROCESS AND ENDORSING INSTITUTIONAL MEASURES TO ENSURE FAIR AND CONSISTENT EVALUTATION OF LEGISLATIVE PERFORMANCE

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) conducts the Local Legislative Awards to recognize exemplary performance, innovation, and best practices of local sanggunians across various local government units (LGUs);

WHEREAS, the credibility and integrity of any award system depend largely on the consistency, fairness, objectivity, and uniformity of its evaluation process;

WHEREAS, it has been observed that different sets of validators or evaluators were assigned to assess different LGUs, resulting in variations in the interpretation, application of criteria, and appreciation of accomplishments;

WHEREAS, the use of varying validators without proper standardization and calibration may give rise to unequal treatment among LGUs, thereby affecting the reliability, comparability, and perceived fairness of evaluation results;

WHEREAS, all LGUs participating in the Local Legislative Awards deserve an equal, transparent, and standardized evaluation process;

WHEREAS, the adoption of clear guidelines and the designation of a uniform or consistently calibrated set of validators across all municipalities will ensure a more objective and equitable appreciation of legislative performance;

WHEREAS, ensuring consistency in evaluation strengthens trust in the award system and reinforces its purpose of promoting excellence, accountability, and good governance in local legislation;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Gene Rose C. Canaya, Chairperson, Committee on Good Government, Justice, Human Rights & Legal Matters and duly seconded by Hon. Pinky A. Jarina, Hon. Adrian S. Camposagrado, Hon. Joel L. Sayson, Hon. Nora Rose T. Tubiano,

Hon. Reynaldo E. Tumabotabo, Hon. Norberto T. Turalba, Hon. Lorna T. Domingo, and Hon. Juliana Marie T. Julaton;

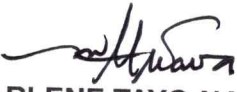
BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that:

1. The Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) is respectfully called upon to review and enhance its evaluation process for the Local Legislative Awards to ensure consistency, fairness, transparency, and uniform application of criteria across all LGUs;
2. The DILG is strongly encouraged to formulate and issue specific and clear guidelines, particularly on the designation, qualifications, roles, and responsibilities of validators, and to ensure that the same set of validators, or a uniformly calibrated and standardized panel, is used in evaluating all municipalities to promote uniform appreciation of legislative performance;
3. The DILG is further urged to adopt transparency measures, including the publication or clear documentation of evaluation criteria, scoring systems, validator guidelines, and calibration processes;
4. Copies of this Resolution be furnished to the Secretary of the Department of the Interior and Local Government, concerned regional and provincial DILG offices, the Philippine Councilor's League (PCL), and other relevant offices for their information and appropriate action.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
