A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE LOCAL CLIMATE CHANGE ACTION PLAN (LCCAP) 2025-2035 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIGBAUAN, ILOILO.

WHEREAS, Section 1, Article II of the Philippine Constitution states that, "The State shall protect and advance the rights of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature;"

WHEREAS, in response to the urgency for action on climate change, the Philippines passed, Republic Act 9729, also known as the "Climate Change Act of 2009". Section 2 states that, "it is the policy of the state to afford full protection and the advancement of the right of people to a balance and healthful ecology to fulfill human needs while maintaining the quality of the natural environment for current and future generation;"

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Tigbauan is mandated to exercise its inherent powers such as police power, as well as share with the national government the responsibility in the management and maintenance of ecological balance in their respective territorial jurisdiction as stated in Section 2a, 15, 3i of Republic Act 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, Section 14 of RA 9729, as amended by RA 10174 provides that, LGUs shall be the frontline agencies in the formulation, planning. Implementation of climate change action plans in their respective areas, consistent with the provisions of RA 7160, the National Framework Strategy on Climate Change (NFSCC), and the National Climate Change Action Plan (NCCAP);

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Tigbauan adopted its guiding principles in the formulation of the Local Climate Change Action Plan 2025-2035 and one of these principles is to envision a climate risk resilient municipality with healthy, safe, prosperous and self-reliant communities, and thriving and productive ecosystems;

WHEREAS, the said 2025-2035 Local Climate Change Action Plan (LCCAP) of this municipality, was formulated to ensure and strengthen the adaptation and mitigation strategies aimed to address the challenges posed by climate change. The plan will serve as a roadmap that

will guide the Municipal Government of Tigbauan in implementing its climate change and disaster risk sensitive development programs and projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of HON. ADRIAN S. CAMPOSAGRADO, Chairman, Committee on Environmental Protection, Disaster Resilience, Housing, Land Utilization, Zonification, Assessment and Expropriation and duly seconded by Hon. Pinky A. Jarina, Hon. Joel L. Sayson, Hon. Marlon R. Teruñez, Hon. Reynaldo E. Tumabotabo, Hon. Norberto T. Turalba, Hon. Lorna T. Domingo and Hon. Juliana Marie T. Julaton;

RESOLVED, to approve and adopt the Ten (10) Year Local Climate Change Action Plan (LCCAP) for 2025-2035 of the Municipality of Tigbauan, Province of Iloilo;
