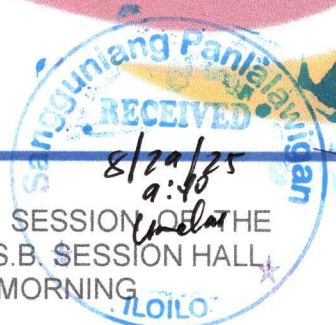




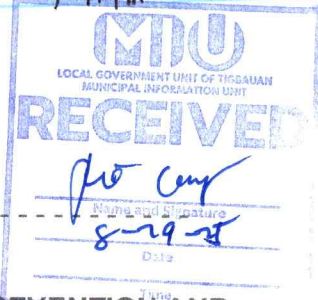
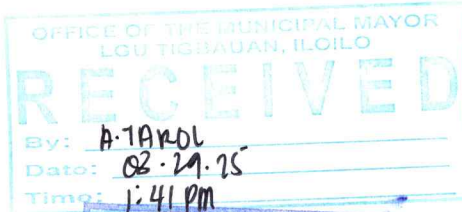

Municipal Ordinance No. 2025-005

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE CHRONIC KIDNEY DISEASE PREVENTION AND CONTROL PROGRAM AND INSTILLING CKD AWARENESS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIGBAUAN, PROVINCE OF ILOILO, PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

EXPLANATORY NOTES

WHEREAS, Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD) is a major public health concern in the Philippines and has been identified as one of the leading causes of morbidity and mortality nationwide;

WHEREAS, early detection and proper management of CKD and its risk factors such as hypertension, diabetes, and unhealthy lifestyle choices can significantly reduce the burden of disease and improve the quality of life of affected individuals;

WHEREAS, the Department of Health (DOH) through Administrative Order No. 2009-0012 established the National Kidney Program aimed at the prevention and control of kidney diseases through health promotion, disease prevention, early detection, and access to quality health care services;

WHEREAS, it is imperative for the Municipality of Tigbauan to localize this national program to address the increasing number of CKD cases and to raise awareness among its constituents regarding kidney health and preventive care;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Tigbauan, Iloilo in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the “**Chronic Kidney Disease Prevention and Control Ordinance of Tigbauan.**”

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It is hereby declared the policy of the Municipality of Tigbauan to safeguard the health and well-being of its constituents by instituting a comprehensive and sustainable strategies for the prevention, early detection, and management of chronic kidney disease through health education, screening, capacity-building, and access to necessary health services.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

- a. Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD) – A long-term condition characterized by a gradual loss of kidney function over time;
- b. High-Risk Individuals – Persons with diabetes, hypertension, or family history of kidney disease;
- c. Screening – Medical procedures such as urinalysis, serum creatinine testing, and blood pressure monitoring to detect early signs of kidney damage;
- d. Awareness Campaign – An organized effort to inform the public about CKD, its risk factors, and preventive strategies.

SECTION 4. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CKD PREVENTION AND CONTROL PROGRAM. There is hereby established a Chronic Kidney Disease Prevention and Control Program under the Municipal Health Office (MHO), which shall:

- a. Conduct regular community-based screenings for early detection of CKD;
- b. Implement health promotion and awareness campaigns on kidney health;
- c. Provide capacity-building and training to local health workers;
- d. Develop referral systems to appropriate health facilities for CKD patients;
- e. Collaborate with national agencies, NGOs, and private sector partners in kidney care and advocacy.

SECTION 5. INTEGRATION WITH BARANGAY HEALTH PROGRAMS. Barangay Health Workers (BHWs) and Barangay Nutrition Scholars (BNS) shall be engaged in the implementation of CKD education and screening activities at the barangay level, in coordination with the MHO.

SECTION 6. MUNICIPAL COUNSELING CENTER/SPACE. There shall be provision of a counseling space for CKD awareness programs, counseling sessions and/or other relevant activities in the municipality.

SECTION 7. MONITORING AND EVALUATION. The Municipal Health Office shall submit an annual report to the Local Chief Executive on the status of the CKD Program, including the number of persons screened, referred, and diagnosed, as well as activities conducted and partnerships established.

SECTION 8. MUNICIPAL CKD AWARENESS MONTH. The month of **June of every year** shall be declared as the Municipal Chronic Kidney Disease Awareness Month to promote advocacies on CKD awareness in the municipality.

SECTION 9. CONTINUOUS TRAINING/CAPACITY BUILDING AND PROMOTION/ ADVOCACY. All-encompassing learning activities and programs designed to increase the capacity, knowledge and skills of health workers and professionals on chronic kidney disease in the municipality must be formulated by the Municipal Health Office.

SECTION 10. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR). The Municipal Health Office shall draft the necessary implementing rules and regulations of this Ordinance not later than 6 months from its effectivity.

SECTION 11. APPROPRIATION. The Local Government Unit of Tigbauan shall set aside an amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance which shall be included in the Annual Budget of the Municipal Health Office (MHO).

SECTION 12. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other sections or provisions hereof not affected by such declaration shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 13. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, resolutions, executive orders, rules and regulations, and other administrative issuance, or any provisions thereof, which are contrary to or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 14. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after compliance with posting and/or publication requirements as provided for under Section 59 of RA 7160.
