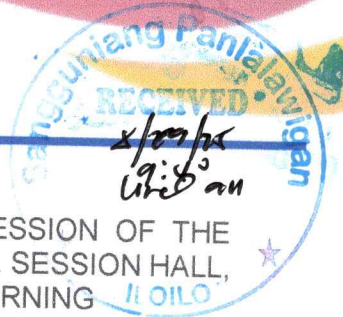

AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING THE BASIC IMMUNIZATION SERVICES FOR INFANTS AND CHILDREN PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF R.A. NO. 10152 AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 10152 otherwise known as "Mandatory Infants and Children Health Immunization Act of 2011", declares the policy of the State to take a proactive role in the preventive health care of infants and children. Towards this end, the State shall adopt a comprehensive, mandatory and sustainable immunization program for vaccine-preventable diseases for all infants and children;

WHEREAS, in accordance to Article II Section 15 of Philippine Constitution, the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, Republic Act 7160 states that every Local Government Unit shall exercise the powers to support and promote health and safety of their respective territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the Local Government of Tigbauan supports the immunization of child to protect them against more diseases and keep other children safe by eliminating or greatly decreasing dangerous diseases that used to spread from child to child;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Tigbauan, Iloilo in session assembled:

SECTION 1. **TITLE.** - This shall be known as *"Strengthened Implementation of Basic Immunization Services for Infants and Children of Tigbauan, Iloilo"*.

SECTION 2. **DEFINITION OF TERMS.** For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

- a. **Basic Immunization Service** - refers to the administration of vaccines to protect individuals, particularly children, from infectious diseases like measles, polio, and influenza. These services aim to prevent diseases outbreaks, establish herd immunity, reduce healthcare costs, and protect vulnerable populations.
- b. **Primary Care Facility** – new name for Rural Health Unit, a medical entity that provides comprehensive care, including treatment, prevention, and rehabilitation. It's often the first point of contact for individuals seeking medical assistance, offering accessible and continuous care.

SECTION. 3. **COVERAGE.** - The mandatory basic immunization for all infants and children provided under this Ordinance shall cover the following vaccine-preventable diseases:

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- (a) Tuberculosis;
 - (b) Diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis;
 - (c) Poliomyelitis;
 - (d) Measles;
 - (e) Mumps;
 - (f) Rubella or German measles;
 - (g) Hepatitis-B;
 - (h) H. Influenza type B (HIB);
 - (i) Pneumonia
 - (j) Meningitis and
 - (k) Such other types as may be determined by the Secretary of Health in a department circular
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The mandatory basic immunization shall be given for free at any government hospital or health center to infants and children from zero (0) to 23 months old. Hepatitis-B vaccine shall be administered by any duly licensed physician, nurse or midwife to infants born in hospitals, health infirmaries, health centers or lying-in centers with obstetrical and pediatric services, whether public or private, within twenty-four (24) hours after birth:



Provided however, that in cases of infants born in places other than the above, any duly licensed physician, nurse or midwife who delivers, or assists in the delivery of the newborn shall be responsible for administering the vaccine to the latter.

Provided further, that for deliveries assisted by persons other than the health professionals mentioned above, the infant should be brought to any available health care facility so as to be immunized against Hepatitis-B within twenty-four (24) hours after birth.

Provided finally, that subsequent doses of Hepatitis-B vaccination shall be completed according to the recommended schedule of Hepatitis-B immunization, as may be provided in the implementing rules and regulations to be issued by the Department of Health (DOH).

SECTION 4. **EDUCATION AND INFORMATION CAMPAIGN.** - All health care practitioners or health care workers who are administering prenatal care shall educate all pregnant mothers on the importance of giving their infants the basic immunization services as well as any possible effects of immunization.

The Primary Care Facility, other government agencies, non-government organizations, professional and academic societies, and local government units shall make available appropriate information materials and shall have a system of its distribution to the public.

SECTION 5. OBLIGATION TO INFORM. - Any physician, nurse, midwife, nursing aide, who delivers, or assists in the delivery of, a newborn shall, prior to delivery, inform parents or legal guardian of the newborn of the availability, nature and benefits of immunization against Hepatitis-B and other vaccine-preventable diseases at birth.

SECTION 6. CONTINUING EDUCATION AND TRAINING OF HEALTH PERSONNEL. - The Provincial Health Office (PHO), with the assistance of local government units, academe, professional societies and non-governmental organizations, shall undertake continuing information, education and training programs for all health personnel on the rationale and benefits of as well as modern procedures for immunization of infants and children against vaccine-preventable diseases.

SECTION 7. RECOGNITION AND INCENTIVE PROGRAM. - An annual recognition and incentive shall be given to achieve 95% compliance and to acknowledge the efforts and hard work of the people behind the program as well as the cooperation and participation of different sectors in the community.

SECTION 8. APPROPRIATION - The Sangguniang bayan upon the recommendation of the Primary Care Facility shall, within the annual budget, appropriate funds exclusive for program and activities that are geared to effectively and efficiently implement the immunization program, pursuant to relevant rules and regulations.

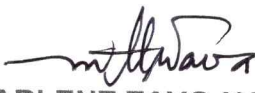
SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. - If, for any reason, any part or provision of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE. - All laws, decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY. - This ordinance shall take effect after complying with the requirements as to mandatory posting as provided for under Section 59 of RA 7160.
