AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE LOCAL LEGISLATIVE AWARD FOR SANGGUNIANG BARANGAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIGBAUAN, PROVINCE OF ILOILO AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIGBAUAN IN SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. - This ordinance shall also be known as “Local Legislative Award [LLA] for Sangguniang Barangay in the Municipality of Tigbauan, Iloilo and Providing Funds thereof also known as Legislative Award for Sangguniang Barangay Ordinance for short.”

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF PRINCIPLE. - The Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Tigbauan was awarded as First Runner Up on the prestigious Local Legislative Award at the National level. The Local Legislative Award [LLA] recognizes the exemplary performance of the sanggunians for legislating measures that help build the foundation of meaningful local administration and development. In order to sustain such practice, the Sangguniang Bayan of Tigbauan shall replicate the award system by instituting it at the barangay level.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS - As used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

3.1. Legislative Agenda - commitment of the legislative body supporting the Program, Project and Activities of the barangay.

3.2. Effectiveness of Performance of the Sanggunian - the impact of the enacted ordinances on local governance; economic growth; public service delivery and environmental sustainability.

3.3. Innovation - the introduction and successful implementation of new or significantly improved ideas, processes or practices that enhance the effectiveness and efficiency of local sanggunian.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

SECTION 4. AWARD CRITERIA. - The LLA has the following criteria:

- 4.1. Responsiveness of Legislative Agenda [25%]
- 4.2. Availability of Legislative Documents [15%]
- 4.3. Effectiveness of Performance of the Sanggunian [30%]
- 4.4. Efficiency of Performance of Sanggunian [20%]
- 4.5. Legislative Citations and Awards [3%]
- 4.6. Capacity Development for Legislators [4%]
- 4.7. Innovation [3%]

SECTION 5. RESPONSIVENESS OF LEGISLATIVE AGENDA [25%]. The extent to which the local legislative body has enacted ordinances and resolutions that effectively respond to the community's needs and align with national and local development goals.

- 5.1. The Legislative Agenda complements the Executive Agenda [5%]
- 5.2. Prior consultation with Stakeholders in the development of the Legislative Agenda [5%]
- 5.3. The Legislative Agenda provides legislative action on the Barangay Development Plan [10%] and
- 5.4. The Legislative Agenda promotes and supports the National, Regional, Provincial and Municipal priority development thrusts [5%].

SECTION 6. AVAILABILITY OF LEGISLATIVE DOCUMENTS [15%]. The completeness, organization, and accessibility of legislative records, including minutes of meetings, ordinances, resolutions and committee reports.

- 6.1. All ordinances and resolutions from 2021 to 2024 are indexed by subject, by sponsor, and by date of approval [3%];
- 6.2. Hard or electronic copies of ordinances and resolutions can be retrieved or accessed on inquiry within a reasonable period of time [2%];
- 6.3. The Journal of Sanggunian proceedings are available [2%];
- 6.4. Minutes of sessions duly signed by majority of all members [3%];
- 6.5. Committee Reports duly signed by majority of all members [3%];
- 6.6. Mechanisms for communicating local legislations are available [2%].

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVENESS OF PERFORMANCE OF THE SANGGUNIAN [30%]. The impact of enacted ordinance on local governance; economic growth; public delivery and environmental sustainability.

- 7.1. Ordinances and resolutions enacted are aligned with the five key pillars of the Philippine Development Plan 2023-2028 and are considered to be priorities [25%], as follows:
 - a. Human Capital Development
 - b. Economic Transformation
 - c. Infrastructure Development
 - d. Climate and Disaster Resilience
 - e. Good Governance and Social Protection
- 7.2. Regular sessions conducted within the required quorum of sanggunian members [5%]

SECTION 8. EFFICIENCY OF PERFORMANCE OF SANGGUNIAN [20%]. The ability of the sanggunian to conduct sessions, deliberations, and hearings in a timely and transparent manner, as well as adherence to established parliamentary procedures.

- 8.1. Processes and Procedures
 - a. Presence of the Internal Rules of Procedure (IRP) [4%]
 - b. Notice of Special Session [2%]
 - c. Submission of Ordinances to the Higher Sanggunian [2%]
 - d. Posting and Publication of ordinances [2%]

8.2. Quality of Office Set-up

- a. Session hall has appropriate fixtures and equipment for the presiding officer [5%]
- b. Legislative offices for individual members have appropriate fixtures and equipment.

SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE CITATIONS AND AWARDS [3%]. Any national, regional, provincial and municipal awards, commendations, or positive external assessment received by the legislative council for outstanding governance.

SECTION 10. CAPACITY DEVELOPMENT FOR LEGISLATORS [4%]. Participation in relevant trainings, workshops and capacity-building programs that enhance legislative competence and governance practice.

SECTION 11. INNOVATIONS [3%]. The introduction and successful implementation of new or significantly improved ideas, processes, or practices that enhance the effectiveness and efficiency of local sanggunian, untimely benefitting their constituents.

SECTION 12. FUNDING. A initial amount of fifty thousand pesos shall be appropriated in the implementation of this ordinance.

SECTION 13. REPEALING CLAUSE.- All resolutions, ordinances and executive Issuances or provisions thereof, which are inconsistent with any of the provisions hereof are hereby accordingly repealed, amended and/or modified.

SECTION 14. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.- Should any provision of this ordinance be subsequently declared unconstitutional or ultra vires, the rest of the provisions not so declared shall remain to be in full force and effect.

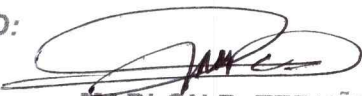
