



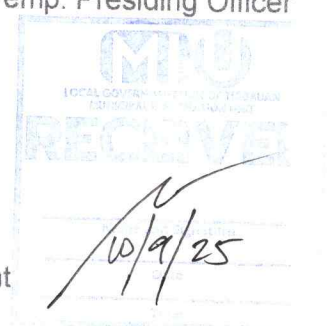

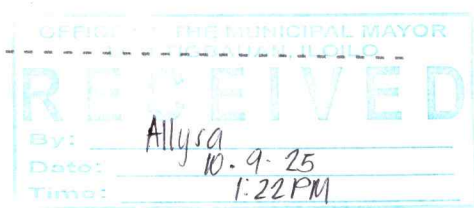
Municipal Ordinance No. 2025-008

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE LOCAL EXCELLENCE IN GOVERNANCE AND ACCOUNTABILITY OF THE COUNCIL FOR THE YOUTH (LEGACY) AWARDS FOR THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIGBAUAN, PROVINCE OF ILOILO, AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, declares that every local government unit shall exercise the powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and to promote the general welfare of its constituents;

WHEREAS, Section 421 of R.A. 7160 provides for the powers and functions of the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK), which include the enactment of resolutions and ordinances for youth development and participation in governance;

WHEREAS, Section 20 of Republic Act No. 10742, otherwise known as the **Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015**, mandates SKs to promulgate policies that will ensure transparency, accountability, and effectiveness in youth governance;

WHEREAS, the Province of Iloilo institutionalized the Program for the Award and Recognition of Outstanding Government Officials and Employees (PARAGON) to inspire excellence, efficiency, and innovation in governance;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Tigbauan recognizes the need to institutionalize a similar program for the Sangguniang Kabataan to promote accountability, innovation, and outstanding legislative performance;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Tigbauan, Province of Iloilo, in session assembled:

SECTION 1. **TITLE.** This Ordinance shall be known as the “LEGACY Awards” or the “Local Excellence in Governance and Accountability of the Council for the Youth Awards.”

SECTION 2. **OBJECTIVES.** The objectives of the **LEGACY Awards** are:

- a. To institutionalize a recognition system for outstanding legislative performance of the Sangguniang Kabataan in Tigbauan;
- b. To encourage innovation, accountability, and effectiveness in SK legislation;
- c. To promote transparency and youth participation in local governance;
- d. To align local youth legislative performance with the standards and objectives of the Iloilo Province’s PARAGON.

SECTION 3. **COVERAGE.** This Award shall cover all duly constituted Barangay Sangguniang Kabataan Councils in the Municipality of Tigbauan.

SECTION 4. **DEFINITION OF TERMS.** As used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

- a. **Sangguniang Kabataan (SK)** – the youth legislative body in every barangay as established under Republic Act No. 10742, also known as the “Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015.”
- b. **LEGACY Awards** – refers to the Local Excellence in Governance and Accountability of the Council for the Youth Awards, an institutionalized recognition program that acknowledges outstanding legislative performance and good governance practices of the Sangguniang Kabataan in the Municipality of Tigbauan.
- c. **Outstanding SK Kagawad in Legislation** – a special recognition conferred to an SK kagawad who has demonstrated exemplary legislative performance, authored impactful youth ordinances, and contributed significantly to the policy-making functions of their SK council.
- d. **Sangguniang Barangay** – the legislative body in the barangay that exercises powers and functions as provided under the Local Government Code of 1991.
- e. **Municipal Screening Committee** – the group duly constituted under this Ordinance tasked to screen, evaluate, and recommend SK councils and officials eligible for the LEGACY Awards.
- f. **Legislative Performance** – the collective outputs, initiatives, and contributions of the SK council in the exercise of their law-making and policy-making functions, including the enactment, implementation, and monitoring of youth-related legislation.
- g. **PARAGON** – refers to the Performance Assessment Result Awards for Governance, a provincial-level recognition program of Iloilo Province, which serves as a model framework for the LEGACY Awards.
- h. **Local Youth Development Office (LYDO)** – the municipal office established under R.A. 10742 responsible for the formulation, coordination, and implementation of youth development programs and policies.
- i. **Compliance Documents** – the set of documents to be submitted by participating SK councils, including enacted ordinances, minutes of sessions, accomplishment reports, and other supporting evidence of legislative performance.

SECTION 5. **CATEGORIES AND CRITERIA.** The following awards shall be conferred annually under the LEGACY Awards. The awards shall be based on, but not limited to, the following criteria:

A. Outstanding Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Council

- a. Functionality (15%)
- b. Plans and Budget/ Reports (30%)
- c. Capacity Development (20%)
- d. Innovations (25%)
- e. Linkage (10%)

B. Outstanding SK Chairperson Award

- a. Leadership (30%)
- b. Capacity development (10%)
- c. Community Projects (10%)
- d. Innovation (25%)
- e. Interview (25%)

C. Outstanding SK Kagawad in Legislation Award

- a. Leadership (30%)
- b. Capacity development (10%)
- c. Community Projects (10%)
- d. Innovation (25%)
- e. Interview (25%)

 SECTION 6. **TIMELINE OF IMPLEMENTATION.** The implementation of the LEGACY Awards shall be conducted annually in accordance with the following timeline:

a. Submission of Entries and Interviews. – All entries and supporting documents for the LEGACY Awards shall be submitted during the fourth (4th) week of November of each year. The Evaluation Committee shall conduct validation and interviews of the nominees within the same period.

b. Deliberation and Finalization of Results. – The Evaluation Committee shall finalize and submit the list of awardees not later than the third (3rd) week of December of the same year.

c. Awarding Ceremony. – The conferment of the LEGACY Awards shall be held in January of the succeeding fiscal year, in time with the celebration of the Municipal Events for the Devotional Fiesta.

d. Annual Conduct. – The process and awarding shall be conducted annually, unless otherwise amended by the Sangguniang Bayan.

 SECTION 7. **SCREENING COMMITTEE.** A Screening Committee shall be created to evaluate, deliberate, and select the awardees for the LEGACY Awards. The Committee shall be composed of, but not limited to, the following:

- a. All Members of the Sangguniang Bayan within their respective barangay coverage, pursuant to the Internal Rules of Procedure (IRP) of the Sanggunian;
- b. Sangguniang Bayan Secretariat/Staff;
- c. Representative from the Municipal Accounting Office;
- d. Local Youth Development Officer (LYDO); and
- e. Representative from the Office of the Municipal Mayor.

 The Screening Committee may invite other resource persons or representatives from partner agencies, civil society organizations, or academic institutions, as may be deemed necessary, to ensure a fair and transparent selection process.

SECTION 8. **IMPLEMENTING BODY.** The Committee on Youth and Sports Development of the Sangguniang Bayan, in coordination with the Municipal Local Government Operations Office (MLGOO) and the Municipal Youth Development Council (MYDC), shall formulate the implementing guidelines and indicators of this Ordinance.

SECTION 9. **AWARDS AND INCENTIVES.** Awardees of the LEGACY Awards shall receive appropriate recognition in the form of:

- a. **Plaque of Recognition** – as a symbol of honor for exemplary legislative performance;
- b. **Certificate of Recognition** – duly signed by the Municipal Mayor and the Sangguniang Bayan; and
- c. **Cash Award or Financial Assistance for Projects** – subject to the availability of funds and in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Commission on Audit (COA). The financial assistance shall be utilized exclusively for youth development projects and programs consistent with the mandate of the Sangguniang Kabataan and the objectives of this Ordinance.

SECTION 10. **FUNDING.** An initial amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos (₱50,000.00) shall be allocated for the conduct of this activity. The Municipality shall likewise allocate at least Fifty Thousand Pesos (₱50,000.00) annually for its continuous implementation. Subsequent funding requirements necessary for the effective implementation of this Ordinance shall be charged to the Municipal Budget or from other available lawful sources, subject to the availability of funds and in accordance with existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

SECTION 11. **REPEALING CLAUSE.** All resolutions, ordinances and executive issuances or provisions thereof, which are inconsistent with any of the provisions hereof are hereby accordingly repealed, amended and/or modified.

SECTION 12. **SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If for any reason, any part or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 13. **EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after compliance with the posting and publication requirements under the Local Government Code of 1991.
